## CROCHET-A-LONG BLANKET (16.012 - 16.023)

### Materials

ELLE FAMILY KNIT DK (50 g ball)

5 balls White 001 | 2 balls each Gravel 075 and Antique 049

1 ball each Duck Egg 223, Mistletoe 274, Fig 207, Cranberry 283, Watermelon 205 and Coral Rose 054

3,5 mm crochet hook

### Measurement

87 cm x 130 cm

Finished square size measures approximately 21 cm x 21 cm  
Make 2 squares

## Important Note

Unless yarn specified is used, SAPROTEX cannot accept responsibility for the finished work.

Owing to printing restrictions the colour reproduction is matched as closely to the yarn as possible.

The instructions are given for one size only.

It is advised to read through the pattern before commencing to gain an understanding of how the pattern is worked.

This pattern uses UK crochet terminology.

## Tension

Is not essential. As long as all squares are worked in an even tension, they should be approximately the same size.

## Colour Change Note

(#) indicates when to cut yarn and/or change colour.

Change colour neatly before working last slst to join by inserting hook, using next colour, yoh and pull through a loop and pull through stitch on hook.

## Materials

ELLE FAMILY KNIT DK (50 g ball)

5 colours of your choice

3,5 mm crochet hook

## SQUARE ONE USED THESE COLOURS

Duck Egg 223

Mistletoe 274

White 001

Gravel 075

Antique 049

beg = begin(ning)

ch = chain

chsp = chain space

dc = double crochet

rep = repeat

rnd = round

# Crochet-a-Long | Square One

FREE PATTERN CODE: 16.012

## Instructions

Using a 3,5 mm hook and Antique, make 4ch, slst in first ch to form a ring.

**1<sup>st</sup> rnd:** 5ch (= 1tr, 2ch), (3tr in ring, 2ch) 3 times, 2tr in ring, slst in 3<sup>rd</sup> of 5ch, cut yarn.

**2<sup>nd</sup> rnd:** Using Mistletoe, slst in chsp, 5ch (= 1tr, 2ch), 3tr in same chsp, \* 1ch, miss 3tr, (3tr, 2ch, 3tr) in next chsp (= corner), rep from \* twice more, 1ch, 2tr in beg chsp, slst in 3<sup>rd</sup> of 5ch, cut yarn.

**3<sup>rd</sup> rnd:** Using Gravel, slst in chsp, 5ch (= 1tr, 2ch), 3tr in same chsp, \* 1ch, 3tr in next 1chsp, 1ch, (3tr, 2ch, 3tr) in corner 2chsp, rep from \* twice more, 1ch, 3tr in next 1chsp, 1ch, 2tr in beg chsp, slst in 3<sup>rd</sup> of 5ch, cut yarn.

**4<sup>th</sup> rnd:** Using Duck Egg, slst in chsp, 5ch (= 1tr, 2ch), 3tr in same chsp, \* (1ch, 3tr in 1chsp) twice, 1ch, (3tr, 2ch, 3tr) in corner 2chsp, rep from \* twice more, (1ch, 3tr in 1chsp) twice, 1ch, 2tr in beg chsp, slst in 3<sup>rd</sup> of 5ch, cut yarn.

**5<sup>th</sup> rnd:** Using White, slst in chsp, 5ch (= 1tr, 2ch), 3tr in same chsp, \* (1ch, 3tr in 1chsp) 3 times, 1ch, (3tr, 2ch, 3tr) in corner 2chsp, rep from \* twice more, (1ch, 3tr in 1chsp) 3 times, 1ch, 2tr in beg chsp, slst in 3<sup>rd</sup> of 5ch, cut yarn.

**6<sup>th</sup> rnd:** Using Antique, slst in chsp, 5ch (= 1tr, 2ch), 2tr in same chsp, \* 1tr in each of next 3tr, 1tr in 1chsp, 1tr in next tr, 9ch, miss 9sts (includes ch sts), 1tr in next tr, 1tr in 1chsp\*\*, 1tr in each of next 3tr, (2tr, 2ch, 2tr) in corner 2chsp, rep from \* twice more, then from \* to \*\* once, 1tr in each of next 2tr, 1tr in slst, 1tr in beg chsp, slst in 3<sup>rd</sup> of 5ch, cut yarn.

**7<sup>th</sup> rnd:** Using Mistletoe, slst in chsp, 5ch (= 1tr, 2ch), 2tr in same chsp, 1tr in each tr, 9ch as previous rnd and (2tr, 2ch, 2tr) in each corner 2chsp around, 1tr in slst, 1tr in beg chsp, slst in 3<sup>rd</sup> of 5ch, cut yarn.

**8<sup>th</sup> rnd:** Using Gravel, as 7<sup>th</sup> rnd.

**9<sup>th</sup> rnd:** Using Duck Egg, slst in chsp, 5ch (= 1tr, 2ch), 2tr in same chsp, \* 11tr, 4ch, 1dc over all 9ch loops, 4ch, 11tr, (2tr, 2ch, 2tr) in corner 2chsp, rep from \* around, 1tr in slst, 1tr in beg chsp, slst in 3<sup>rd</sup> of 5ch, cut yarn.

**10<sup>th</sup> rnd:** Using White, slst in chsp, 3ch, (= 1dc, 2ch), 2dc in same chsp, \* 13dc, 6ch, 13dc, (2dc, 2ch, 2dc) in corner 2chsp, rep from \* around, 1dc in slst, 1dc in beg chsp, slst in first ch.

**11<sup>th</sup> rnd:** (1dc, 2ch, 1dc) in corner, 2chsp, 1dc in each dc and 1dc in each of 6ch around, slst in first dc, fasten off.

Secure and weave in all ends.

Block square to measurement, cover with a damp cloth and allow to dry.



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
