

Finished square size measures approximately 21 cm x 21 cm
Make 2 squares

Owing to printing restrictions the colour reproduction is matched as closely to the yarn as possible.

The instructions are given for one size only.

It is advised to read through the pattern before commencing to gain an understanding of how the pattern is worked.

This pattern uses UK crochet terminology.

Tension

Is not essential. As long as all squares are worked in an even tension, they should be approximately the same size.

Colour Change Note

(#) indicates when to cut yarn and/or change colour.

Change colour neatly before working last slst to join by inserting hook, using next colour, yoh and pull through a loop and pull through stitch on hook.

Materials

ELLE FAMILY KNIT DK (50 g ball)

5 colours of your choice

3,5 mm crochet hook

SQUARE FIVE USED THESE COLOURS

Cranberry 283

White 001

Gravel 075

Antique 049

beg = begin(ning)

rep = repeat

ch = chain

rnd = round

chsp = chain space

slst = slip stitch

dc = double crochet

st(s) = stitch(es)

Special Stitch

tr cluster = (yoh, insert hook in stitch and pull through a loop, yoh and pull through 2 loops) over the number of stitches indicated, yoh and pull through all loops on hook, 1 ch to close (= eye)

Instructions

Using a 3,5 mm hook and Antique, make 2ch.

1st rnd: 8dc in 2nd ch from hook, slst in first dc.

2nd rnd: 1ch (not a st), 2dc in same place as slst, 2dc in each dc around, (#) slst in first dc.

3rd rnd: Using Gravel, 3ch (= 1tr), *1htr in next dc, 1dc in next dc, 1htr in next dc, 1tr in next dc, rep from * twice more, 1htr in next dc, 1dc in next dc, 1htr in next dc, (#) slst in top of 3ch.

4th rnd: Using White, 1ch (not a st), 1dc in same place as slst, *1htr in htr, 1tr in dc, 1dtr in htr, 4ch**, 1dc in tr, rep from * twice more, then from * to ** once, slst in first dc, fasten off.

5th rnd: Using Cranberry, slst in 4chsp, 1ch (not a st), *(2dc, 2htr) in 4chsp, 1tr in dc, 1tr in htr, 1dtr in tr, 1dtr in dtr, 4ch, rep from * 3 times more, slst in first dc, fasten off.

6th rnd: Using Fig, slst in 4chsp, 1ch (not a st), *(3dc, 1htr) in 4chsp, 1htr in each of next 2dc, 1tr in each of next 2htr, 1tr in tr, 1dtr in tr, 1dtr in each of next 2dtr, 4ch, rep from * 3 times more, slst in first dc, fasten off.

7th rnd: Using Gravel, slst in 4chsp, 1ch (not a st), *4dc in 4chsp, 1htr in each of next 3dc and next htr, 1tr in each of next 2htr and next 2tr, 1dtr in each of next tr and next 3dtr, 4ch, rep from * 3 times more, slst in first dc, fasten off.

8th rnd: Using White, slst in 4chsp, 1ch (not a st), *4dc in 4chsp, 1htr in each of next 4dc and next 2htr, 1tr in each of next 2htr and next 3tr, 1dtr in each of next tr and next 4dtr, 4ch, rep from * 3 times more, (#) slst in first dc.

9th rnd: Using Antique, 1ch (= 1dc), *1dc in each st to 4chsp, 3ch, 3dc in 4chsp, rep from * 3 times more, slst in beg ch, fasten off.

10th rnd: Using Cranberry, slst in corner 3chsp, 3ch (= 1tr), (1tr, 2ch, 2tr) in same 3chsp, *(1dc in each of next 3dc, miss 3dc, 7tr in next dc, miss 3dc) twice, 1dc in each of next 3dc**, (2tr, 2ch, 2tr) in corner 3chsp, rep from * twice more, then from * to ** once, slst in top of 3ch and next tr (#).

11th rnd: Using Fig, slst in corner 2chsp, 3ch (= 1tr), (1tr, 2ch, 2tr) in same 2chsp, *[3ch, tr cluster over next 7sts (= 2tr, 3dc, 2tr), 3ch, 1dc in each of next 3tr] twice, 3ch, tr cluster over next 7sts, 3ch**, (2tr, 2ch, 2tr) in corner 2chsp, rep from * twice more, then from * to ** once, slst in top of 3ch and next tr (#).

12th rnd: Using Gravel, slst in corner 2chsp, 3ch (= 1tr), (1tr, 2ch, 2tr) in same 2chsp, *miss 1tr, 1tr in next tr, (1ch, 4tr in eye of tr cluster, 1ch, 1tr in each of next 3dc) twice, 1ch, 4tr in eye of tr cluster, 1ch, miss 1tr, 1tr in next tr**, (2tr, 2ch, 2tr) in corner 2chsp, rep from * twice more, then from * to ** once, slst in top of 3ch and next tr (#).

13th rnd: Using White, slst in corner 2chsp, 1ch (= 1dc), 2ch, 1dc in same 2chsp, *1dc in each tr and 1dc in each 1chsp to corner, (1dc, 2ch, 1dc) in corner 2chsp, rep from * around, slst in beg ch, fasten off.

Secure and weave in all ends.

Block square to measurement, cover with a damp cloth and allow to dry.



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
