

Finished square size measures approximately 21 cm x 21 cm
Make 2 squares

Important Note

Unless yarn specified is used, SAPROTEX cannot accept responsibility for the finished work.

Owing to printing restrictions the colour reproduction is matched as closely to the yarn as possible.

The instructions are given for one size only.

It is advised to read through the pattern before commencing to gain an understanding of how the pattern is worked.

This pattern uses UK crochet terminology.

Tension

Is not essential. As long as all squares are worked in an even tension, they should be approximately the same size.

Colour Change Note

(#) indicates when to cut yarn and/or change colour.

Change colour neatly before working last slst to join by inserting hook, using next colour, yoh and pull through a loop and pull through stitch on hook.

Materials

ELLE FAMILY KNIT DK (50 g ball)

5 colours of your choice

3,5 mm crochet hook

SQUARE SIX USED THESE COLOURS

Watermelon 205

Coral Rose 054

White 001

Gravel 075

Antique 049



Abbreviations

beg = begin(ning)	rep = repeat

Special Stitch

v-st = (1tr, 1ch, 1tr) in indicated place

Magic Ring



Wrap the yarn twice around your index and middle fingers, insert hook under the strands and pull through a loop. Slip the yarn from your fingers and work one chain stitch to secure the ring. Once you have worked the first round, pull on the shorter end to pull the ring closed.

Crochet-a-Long | Square Six

Instructions

Using a 3,5 mm hook and Watermelon, beg with a magic ring.

1st rnd: 3ch (= 1tr), 1ch, (1tr in ring, 1ch) 7 times, pull ring closed, slst in 3rd ch.

2nd rnd: Slst in 1chsp, 3ch (= 1tr), 1ch, 1tr in same chsp (= v-st), (1tr, v-st) in same sp, *miss 1chsp, (v-st, 1tr, v-st) in next 1chsp, rep from * twice more, slst in 3rd ch.

3rd rnd: Slst in 1chsp, 3ch (= 1tr), 1ch, 1tr in same 1chsp (= v-st), *miss 1tr, 3tr in next tr (= tr between the v-st trs), v-st in next v-st, 1ch**, v-st in next v-st, rep from * twice more, then from * to ** once, slst in 3rd ch, cut yarn.

4th rnd: Using Antique, slst in 1chsp, 3ch (= 1tr), 1tr in same 1chsp, *1ch, v-st in sp between 1st and 2nd tr of 3tr group, v-st in sp between 2nd and 3rd tr of 3tr group, 1ch, 2tr in v-st, 2ch**, 2tr in next v-st, rep from * twice more, then from * to ** once, (#) slst in top of 3ch.

5th rnd: Using White, 3ch (= 1tr), 1tr in same place as slst, *1tr in next tr, 1ch, v-st in v-st, 1tr in sp between v-sts, v-st in v-st, 1ch, 2tr in next tr, 1tr in next tr, 2ch**, 2tr in next tr, rep from * twice more, then from * to ** once, (#) slst in top of 3ch.

6th rnd: Using Gravel, 3ch (= 1tr), 1tr in each of next 2tr, *2ch, 2tr in v-st, 1tr in sp between v-st and tr, 1tr in sp between tr and next v-st, 2tr in v-st, (2ch, 1tr in each of next 3tr)** twice, rep from * twice more, then from * to ** once, 2ch, slst in top of 3ch, fasten off.

7th rnd: Using Coral Rose, slst in 2chsp after beg 3tr, 4ch (= 1dtr), 7dtr in same chsp, *1dc in sp between 3rd and 4th tr, 8dtr in next 2chsp, 3dc in next 2chsp**, 8dtr in next 2chsp, rep from * twice more, then from * to ** once, slst in top of 4ch, fasten off.

8th rnd: Using Antique, slst in any single dc between fans, 3ch (= 1tr), *1ch, miss 2dtr of fan, 2dc in next dtr, 1dc in each of next 2dtr, 2dc in next dtr, 1ch, 2tr in dc, (1dtr, 1ch, 1dtr) in next dc, 2tr in next dc, 1ch, miss 2dtr of fan, 2dc in next dtr, 1dc in each of next 2dtr, 2dc in next dtr, 1ch, 1tr in dc, rep from * around omitting last tr in dc, (#) slst in 3rd ch.

9th rnd: Using White, 1ch (not a st), 1dc in same place as slst, *1dc in 1chsp, 1dc in each of next 6dc, 1htr in 1chsp, (4tr, 2ch, 4tr) in 1chsp between dtrs, 1htr in 1chsp, 1dc in each of next 6dc, 1dc in 1chsp, dc in tr, rep from * around omitting last dc in tr, (#) slst in first dc.

10th rnd: Using Watermelon, 3ch (= 1tr), *(miss 1 st, 1tr in next st, 1tr in missed st) 6 times, (2tr, 2ch, 2tr) in corner 2chsp, (miss 1 st, 1tr in next st, 1tr in missed st) 6 times, 1tr in next dc, rep from * around omitting last tr in dc, (#) slst in top of 3ch.


11th rnd: Using Gravel, 1ch (not a st), 1dc in same place as slst, 1dc in each tr to corner and (1dc, 2ch, 1dc) in each corner 2chsp around, (#) slst in first dc.

12th rnd: Using Coral Rose, 1ch (not a st), 1dc in same place as slst, 1dc in each dc to corner, (1dc, 2ch, 1dc) in each corner 2chsp around, (#) slst in first dc.

13th rnd: Using White, work as 12th rnd, fasten off.


Secure and weave in all ends.

Block square to measurement, cover with a damp cloth and allow to dry.
