

Finished square size measures approximately 21 cm x 21 cm
Make 2 squares

Important Note

Unless yarn specified is used, SAPROTEX cannot accept responsibility for the finished work.

Owing to printing restrictions the colour reproduction is matched as closely to the yarn as possible.

The instructions are given for one size only.

It is advised to read through the pattern before commencing to gain an understanding of how the pattern is worked.

This pattern uses UK crochet terminology.

Tension

Is not essential. As long as all squares are worked in an even tension, they should be approximately the same size.

Colour Change Note

(#) indicates when to cut yarn and/or change colour.

Change colour neatly before working last slst to join by inserting hook, using next colour, yoh and pull through a loop and pull through stitch on hook.

Materials

ELLE FAMILY KNIT DK (50 g ball)

5 colours of your choice

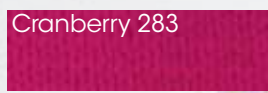
3,5 mm crochet hook

SQUARE EIGHT USED THESE COLOURS

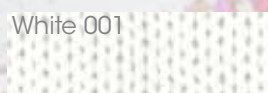

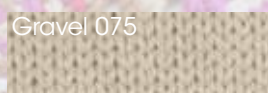

Abbreviations

beg = begin(ning)

rnd = round

ch = chain

slst = slip stitch

chsp = chain space

sp = space

dc = double crochet

st(s) = stitch(es)

dtr = double treble

tr(s) = treble(s)

htr = half treble

yoh = yarn over hook

rep = repeat

Special Stitches

bobble = 4tr in indicated place, remove hook from last tr, insert hook in first tr and in dropped loop of last tr, yoh and pull through both loops on hook

NOTE: To work first bobble = 3ch (= 1tr), 3tr in indicated place, remove hook from last tr, insert hook in top of 3ch and in dropped loop of last tr, yoh and pull through both loops on hook

dc spike = a double crochet worked in the normal manner but over a number of rounds thus pulling up a longer loop

double v-st = (2tr, 1ch, 2tr) in indicated stitch

Crochet-a-Long | Square Eight

FREE PATTERN CODE: 16.019

Instructions

Using a 3,5 mm hook and Fig, make 6ch, slst in first ch to form a ring.

1st rnd: 5ch (= 1dtr, 1ch), (1dtr, 1ch) 15 times in ring, (#) slst in 4th ch.

2nd rnd: Using White, 1ch (not a st), 1dc in same place as slst, (2dc in 1chsp, 1dc in dtr) around ending 2dc in last 1chsp, (#) slst in first dc.

3rd rnd: Using Gravel, 3ch (= 1tr), 1tr in each dc around, slst in top of 3ch and next tr (#).

4th rnd: Using Cranberry, slst in sp between trs (= tr just worked into and next tr), bobble in same sp, *4ch, miss 3tr, bobble in sp between last and next trs, rep from * around ending 4ch, slst in top of first bobble (#).

5th rnd: Using Fig, slst in 4chsp, 1ch (not a st), 5dc in same 4chsp, *turn work, 6ch, slst in first of 5dc, turn work, 2ch (= 1htr), 10htr in 6ch loop, 3dc in next 4chsp**, 5dc in next 4chsp, rep from * around ending at **, slst in first dc, fasten off.

6th rnd: Using White, slst in middle dc of any 3dc group, 3ch (= 1tr), (1tr, 1ch, 2tr) in same dc, *2ch, working behind petal, 1dc in each of next 5dc, 2ch**, double v-st in middle dc of 3dc group, rep from * around ending at **, (#) slst in top of 3ch.

7th rnd: Using Gravel, 1ch (not a st), 1dc in same place as slst, 1dc in each of next tr, 1chsp and 2tr, *miss 2ch and 2htr of petal, 1dc in each of next 5htr (there should be 3htr of petal remaining), 1ch, (1tr, 1ch, 1tr, 2ch, 1tr, 1ch, 1tr) in 1chsp of double v-st, 1ch, miss 2ch and 2htr of next petal, 1dc in each of next 5htr**, 1dc in each of next 2tr, 1chsp and 2tr, rep from * twice more, then from * to ** once, (#) slst in first dc.

8th rnd: Using Antique, 2ch (= 1htr), 1htr in each of next 9dc, *(1tr in next 1chsp, 1ch) twice, (1tr, 1ch, 1tr, 2ch, 1tr, 1ch, 1tr) in corner 2chsp, (1ch, 1tr in next 1chsp) twice**, 1htr in each of next 15dc, rep from * twice more, then from * to ** once, 1htr in each of next 5dc, slst in top of 2ch, fasten off.

9th rnd: Using Cranberry, slst in any corner 2chsp, 1ch (= 1dc), 2ch, 1dc in same 2chsp, *(1ch, 1dc in next 1chsp) 3 times, (1ch, miss next st, 1dc in next htr) 8 times, (1ch, 1dc in next 1chsp) 3 times, 1ch**, (1dc, 2ch, 1dc) in corner 2chsp, rep from * around ending at **, slst in beg ch (#).

10th rnd: Using Gravel, slst in corner 2chsp, 1ch (= 1dc), 2ch, 1dc in same 2chsp, *(1ch, 1dc spike in tr of 8th rnd) 4 times, (1ch, 1dc spike in missed htr of 8th rnd) 7 times, (1ch, 1dc spike in tr of 8th rnd) 4 times, 1ch**, (1dc, 2ch, 1dc) in corner 2chsp, rep from * around ending at **, slst in beg ch (#).

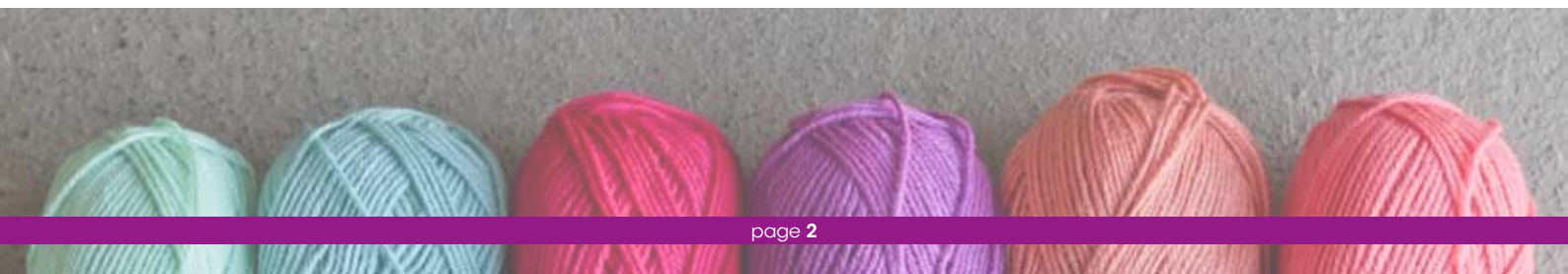
11th rnd: Using Fig, slst in corner 2chsp, 1ch (= 1dc), 2ch, 1dc in same 2chsp, *(1ch, 1dc spike in dc of 9th rnd) to corner, 1ch**, (1dc, 2ch, 1dc) in corner 2chsp, rep from * around ending at **, slst in beg ch (#).

12th rnd: Using Antique work as for 11th rnd but working into dc spike of 10th rnd.

13th rnd: Using White, slst in corner 2chsp, 1ch (= 1dc), 2ch, 1dc in same 2chsp, *1dc in next dc, (1dc spike in dc spike of 11th rnd, 1dc in next dc spike) to corner, placing last dc in dc before 2ch, (1dc, 2ch, 1dc) in corner 2chsp, rep from * around, slst in beg ch, fasten off.

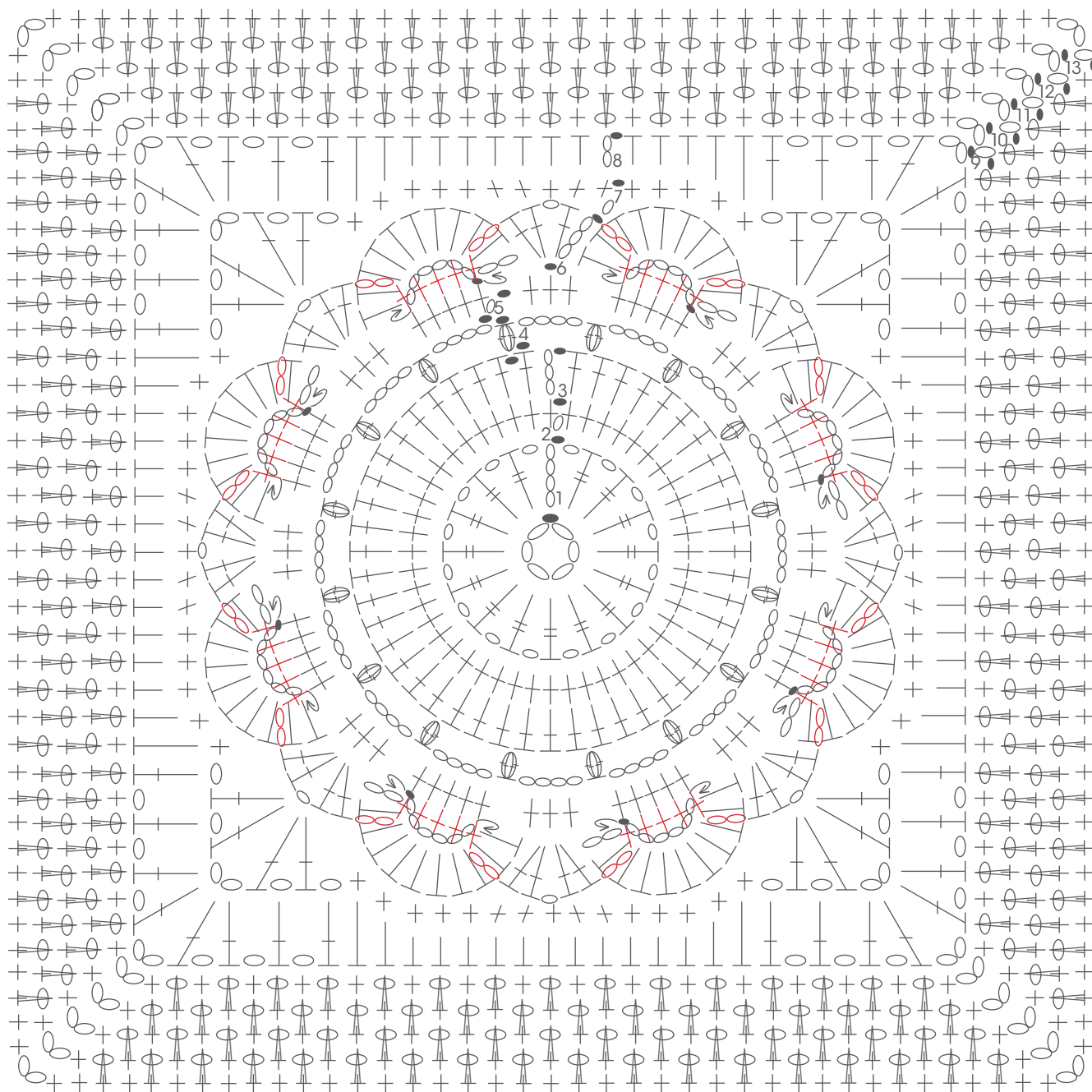
Secure and weave in all ends.

Block square to measurement, cover with a damp cloth and allow to dry.
