

Finished square size measures approximately 21 cm x 21 cm
Make 2 squares

BEGINNER - INTERMEDIATE



Important Note

Unless yarn specified is used, SAPROTEX cannot accept responsibility for the finished work.

Owing to printing restrictions the colour reproduction is matched as closely to the yarn as possible.

The instructions are given for one size only.

It is advised to read through the pattern before commencing to gain an understanding of how the pattern is worked.

This pattern uses UK crochet terminology.

Tension

Is not essential. As long as all squares are worked in an even tension, they should be approximately the same size.

Colour Change Note

(#) indicates when to cut yarn and/or change colour.

Change colour neatly before working last slst to join by inserting hook, using next colour, yoh and pull through a loop and pull through stitch on hook.

Materials

ELLE FAMILY KNIT DK (50 g ball)

5 colours of your choice

3,5 mm crochet hook

SQUARE TEN USED THESE COLOURS

Duck Egg 223

Mistletoe 274

White 001

Gravel 075

Antique 049



Abbreviations

beg = begin(ning)

ch = chain

chsp = chain space

dc = double crochet

dtr = double treble

htr = half treble

rep = repeat

rnd = round

slst = slip stitch

sp = space

st(s) = stitch(es)

tog = together

tr = treble

yoh = yarn over hook

Special Abbreviation

fphtr/tr = front post half treble/treble: Work a half treble/treble inserting hook from behind work, right to left in front of stem of stitch of previous round

Special Stitches

picot clover = 3ch, slst in first of these ch, 5ch, slst in slst, 3ch, slst in slst

puff = (yoh, insert hook in indicated place and pull through a loop) 4 times, yoh and pull through all loops on hook, 1ch to close puff (= eye)

tr3(4)tog = (yoh, insert hook in indicated place and pull through a loop, yoh and pull through 2 loops only)

3(4) times, yoh and pull through all loops on hook

v-st = (1tr, 1ch, 1tr) in indicated place

Crochet-a-Long | Square Ten

FREE PATTERN CODE: 16.021

Instructions

Using a 3,5 mm hook and Duck Egg make 6ch.

1st rnd: 3ch (= 1tr), 11tr in ring, slst in top of 3ch.

2nd rnd: * 3ch, tr4tog in next tr, 3ch, 1dc in next tr, rep from * 5 times more, placing last dc in same place as 1st rnd slst, fasten off.

3rd rnd: Using Antique, slst in same place as 1st rnd slst, 3ch (= 1tr), 1ch, 1tr in same place as slst (= v-st), * 2ch, 1dc in top of cluster, 2ch, v-st in same st as dc, rep from * 4 times more, 2ch, 1dc in top of cluster, 2ch, slst in top of 3ch, (#).

4th rnd: Using Mistletoe, slst in 1chsp of v-st, 3ch, tr3tog in same 1chsp, * 3ch, tr3tog in dc, 3ch, tr4tog in 1chsp of v-st, rep from * 4 times more, 3ch, tr3tog in dc, 3ch, slst in top of cluster, (#).

5th rnd: Using White, slst in 3chsp, 3ch (= 1tr), 4tr in same 3chsp, (1dc in top of next cluster, 5tr in next 3chsp) around, 1dc in top of last cluster, slst in top of 3ch, fasten off.

6th rnd: Using Duck Egg, slst in any dc between fans, puff in same dc, * 1ch, miss first tr of fan, 1fpftr around each of next 3tr, 1ch**, puff in dc, rep from * around ending at **, slst in eye of puff, (#).

7th rnd: Using White, slst in first 1chsp, 1ch (= 1dc), * 3ch, tr3tog by working 1 stem in each of next 3htr, 3ch, 1dc in next 1chsp**, miss puff, 1dc in next 1chsp, rep from * around ending at **, slst in beg ch, fasten off.

8th rnd: Using Gravel, slst in sp between last dc and beg ch of 7th rnd, 3ch (= 1tr), 1ch, 1tr in same sp (= v-st), * 3ch, 1dc in top of cluster, 3ch, v-st in sp between next 2dc, 3ch, 1dc in top of cluster, 3ch, 1dc in next dc, picot clover (see *special stitches*), 1dc in next dc, 3ch, 1dc in top of cluster, 3ch**, v-st in sp between next 2dc, rep from * twice more, then from * to ** once, (#) slst in top of 3ch.

9th rnd: Using Antique, * 2dc in 1chsp of v-st, 3dc in each of next 2x 3chsp, 2dc in 1chsp of v-st, 3dc in next 3chsp, working behind picot group, 9dtr at base of picot (*you will see a strand between the 2dc, work over this strand*), miss next 3ch loop, 3dc in next 3chsp, rep from * 3 times more, (#) slst in first dc.

10th rnd: Using Duck Egg, 2ch (= 1htr), 1htr in each of next 12dc, * 1fpftr around each of next 4dtr, (1fpftr, 1ch, 1fpftr in back loops at base of previous fpftr) around next dtr, 1fpftr around each of next 4dtr**, 1htr in each of next 16dc, rep from * twice more, then from * to ** once, 1htr in each of next 3dc, slst in top of 2ch, fasten off.

11th rnd: Using Mistletoe, slst in corner 1chsp, 3ch (= 1tr), 1ch, 1tr in same 1chsp, * 1fpftr around each of next 26sts, (1tr, 1ch, 1tr) in corner 1chsp, rep from * around, slst in top of 3ch, (#).

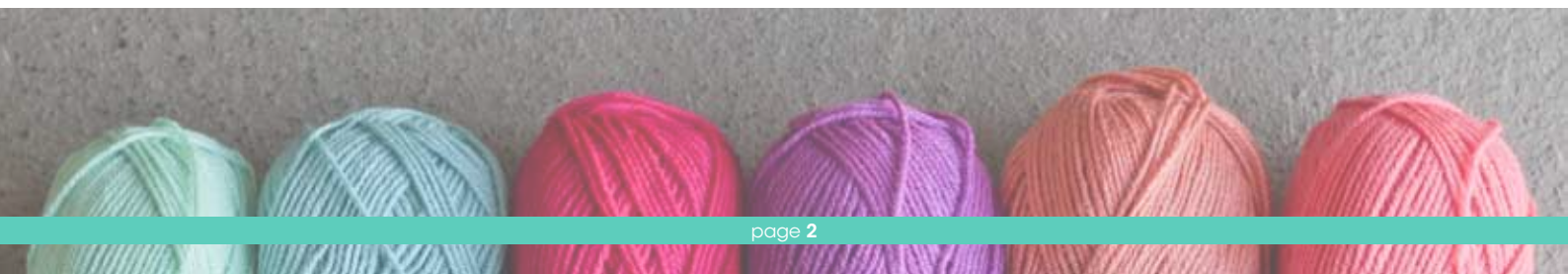
12th rnd: Using Gravel, slst in corner 1chsp, 3ch (= 1tr), 1ch, 1tr in same 1chsp, * 1fpftr around each of next 28sts, (1tr, 1ch, 1tr) in corner 1chsp, rep from * around, slst in top of 3ch, (#).

13th rnd: Using White, slst in corner 1chsp, 3ch (= 1tr), 1ch, 1tr in same 1chsp, * 1fpftr around each of next 30sts, (1tr, 1ch, 1tr) in corner 1chsp, rep from * around, slst in top of 3ch.

14th rnd: * (1dc, 1ch, 1dc) in corner 1chsp, 1dc in each st to next corner, rep from * around, slst in first dc, fasten off.

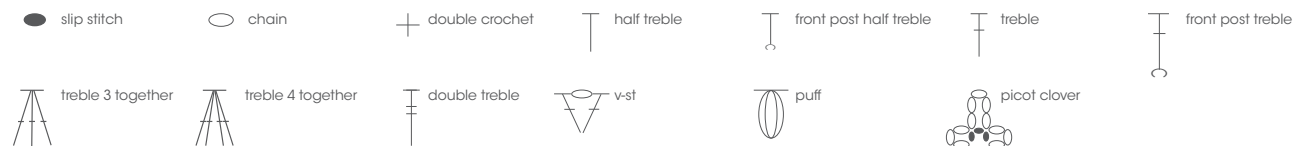
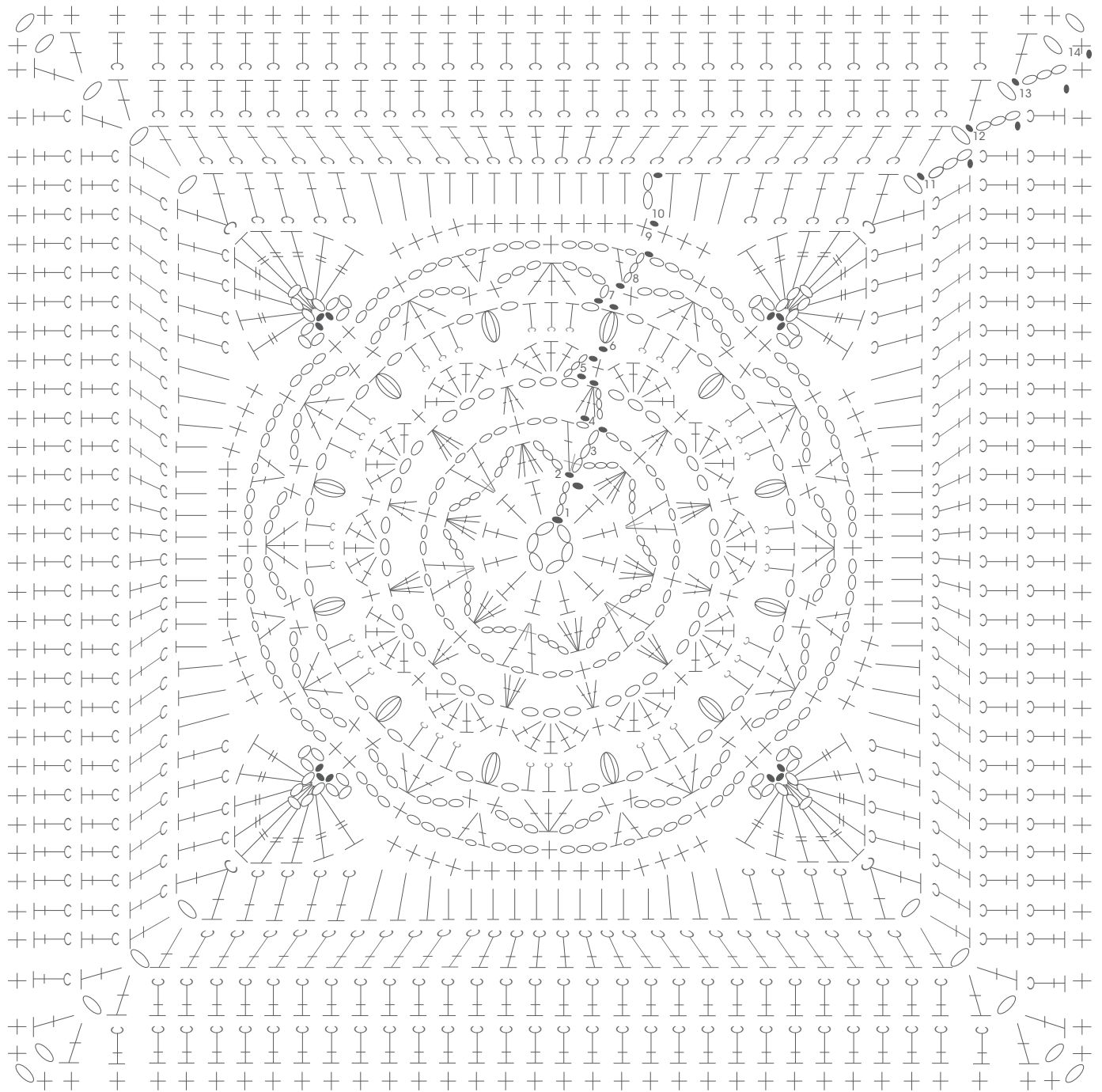
Secure and weave in all ends.

Block square to measurement, cover with a damp cloth and allow to dry.
