

Finished square size measures approximately 21 cm x 21 cm
Make 2 squares

Unless yarn specified is used, SAPROTEX cannot accept responsibility for the finished work.

Owing to printing restrictions the colour reproduction is matched as closely to the yarn as possible.

The instructions are given for one size only.

It is advised to read through the pattern before commencing to gain an understanding of how the pattern is worked.

This pattern uses UK crochet terminology.

Tension

Is not essential. As long as all squares are worked in an even tension, they should be approximately the same size.

Colour Change Note

(#) indicates when to cut yarn and/or change colour.

Change colour neatly before working last slst to join by inserting hook, using next colour, yoh and pull through a loop and pull through stitch on hook.

Materials

ELLE FAMILY KNIT DK (50 g ball)

5 colours of your choice

3,5 mm crochet hook

6 stitch markers

SQUARE ELEVEN USED THESE COLOURS

Gravel 075

Antique 049

beg = begin(ning)

ch = chain

Special Stitches

picot = 3ch, slst in first ch

puff = (yoh, insert hook in indicated place and pull through a loop) 4 times, yoh and pull through all loops on hook, 1ch to close puff (= eye)

v-st = (1tr, 1ch, 1tr) in indicated place

Instructions

Using a 3,5mm hook and Cranberry, make 2ch.

1st rnd: 6dc in 2nd ch from hook, slst in first dc.

2nd rnd: (Puff, 1ch) in each dc around, slst in eye of first puff.

3rd rnd: 2ch (= 1htr), 1ch, 1htr in same place as slst, * 1ch, (1htr, 1ch, 1htr) in eye of next puff, rep from * around ending 1ch, slst in top of 2ch.

4th rnd: Slst in 1chsp, 3ch, slst in same 1chsp, (slst in next 1chsp, 3ch, slst in same 1chsp) around, fasten off.

5th rnd: Using Gravel and working behind previous rnds, slst in 1chsp of 2nd rnd, 4ch (= 1dtr), 2dtr in same 1chsp, (3ch, 3dtr in next 1chsp of 2nd rnd) around ending 3ch, slst in top of 4ch.

6th rnd: 3ch (= 1tr), 1tr in each of next 2dtr, * 2ch, 1tr through picot (inserting hook from behind) directly below, 2ch, 1tr in each of next 3dtr, rep from * 4 times more, 2ch, 1tr through picot directly below, 2ch, slst in top of 3ch.

7th rnd: * 3ch, slst in same tr, slst in next tr, 5ch, slst in same tr, slst in next tr, 3ch, slst in same tr, 2ch, working behind 6th rnd, 1dc in 3chsp of 5th rnd, 2ch**, slst in next tr, rep from * 4 times more, then from * to ** once, slst in slst at beg, fasten off.

8th rnd: Using Fig, slst in any dc of 7th rnd, 3ch (= 1tr), 4tr in same dc, * 1ch, v-st between 1st and 2nd dtrs of 5th rnd, v-st between 2nd and 3rd dtrs of 5th rnd, 1ch**, 5tr in next dc, rep from * 4 times more, then from * to ** once, slst in top of 3ch.

9th rnd: 3ch (= 1tr), 1ch, (1tr in next tr, 1ch) 4 times, * 1dtr in 1chsp of v-st, 1ch, 1dtr in 1chsp of next v-st, (1ch, 1tr in next tr) 5 times, 1ch, rep from * 4 times more, 1dtr in 1chsp of v-st, 1ch, 1dtr in 1chsp of next v-st, 1ch, slst in top of 3ch.

10th rnd: 1ch (not a st), 1dc in same place as slst, 1dc in 1chsp, 1dc in tr, * 1dc in 1chsp, 2dc in next tr, (1dc in next 1chsp, 1dc in next st) 6 times, rep from * 4 times more, 1dc in 1chsp, 2dc in next tr, (1dc in next 1chsp, 1dc in next st) 4 times, 1dc in 1chsp, (#) slst in first dc.

11th rnd: Using Gravel, 1ch (not a st), 1dc in same place as slst, 1dc in each dc around, (#) slst in first dc.

12th rnd: Using White, 2ch (= 1htr), 1htr in each of next 4dc, * 1ch, miss next dc, (v-st in next dc, miss 2dc) twice, v-st in next dc, 1ch, 1tr in each of next 3dc, 1htr in each of next 2dc, 1dc in next dc, 2dc in next dc, 1dc in each of next 2dc, 1htr in each of next 2dc, 1tr in each of next 3dc, 1ch, (v-st in next dc, miss 2dc) twice, v-st in next dc, 1ch*, miss next dc, 1htr in each of next 15dc, rep from * to *, miss next dc, 1htr in each of next 10dc, slst in top of 2ch.

13th rnd: 1ch (not a st), 1dc in same place as slst, 1dc in each of next 4sts, * 1ch, puff in 1chsp of v-st, [(1tr, picot) 3 times, 1tr] in 1chsp of next v-st, puff in 1chsp of next v-st, 1ch**, miss 1chsp, 1dc in each of next 15sts, rep from * twice more, then rep from * to ** once, miss 1chsp, 1dc in each of next 10sts, slst in first dc, fasten off.

14th rnd: Using Antique, slst in first dc after top right hand corner, 1ch (not a st), 1dc in same place as slst, 1dc in each of next 14dc, * working behind previous rnd, 1tr in sp between last st and v-st of 12th rnd, 1ch, v-st in sp between v-sts of 12th rnd, 3ch, v-st in sp between previous and last v-st, 1ch, 1tr in sp between last v-st and next st**, 1dc in each of next 15dc, rep from * twice more, then rep from * to ** once, slst in first dc.

15th rnd: 1ch (not a st), 1dc in same place as slst, 1dc in each of next 14dc, * 1htr in tr, 1htr in 1chsp, 1tr in each of next tr, 1chsp and next tr, (2tr, 2ch, 2tr) in corner 3chsp, 1tr in each of next tr, 1chsp and next tr, 1htr in 1chsp, 1htr in tr**, 1dc in each of next 15dc, rep from * twice more, then from * to ** once, slst in first dc, fasten off.

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16th rnd: Using White, slst in corner 2chsp, 1ch (= 1dc), *working in front, puff in centre picot below, 1dc in same 2chsp, 1dc in each of next 5sts, puff in eye of puff below, miss 1 st (hidden behind puff just made), 1dc in each of next 17sts, puff in eye of puff below, miss 1 st, 1dc in each of next 5sts**, 1dc in corner 2chsp, rep from * twice more, then from * to ** once, slst in beg ch, (#).

17th rnd: Using Fig, 1ch (= 1dc), (1dc, 2ch, 1dc) in eye of corner puff, 1dc in each of next 6dc, 1dc in eye of puff, 1dc in each dc to next puff, 1dc in eye of puff**, 1dc in each of next 6dc, rep from * twice more, then from * to ** once, 1dc in each of next 5dc, (#) slst in beg ch.

18th rnd: Using Cranberry, 1ch (= 1dc), 1dc in each dc and (1dc, 1ch, 1dc) in each corner chsp around, (#) slst in beg ch.

19th rnd: Using White, work as for 18th rnd, fasten off.



Secure and weave in all ends.

Block square to measurement, cover with a damp cloth and allow to dry.
