Owing to printing restrictions the colour reproduction is matched as closely to the yarn as possible.

The instructions are given for one size only.

It is advised to read through the pattern before commencing to gain an understanding of how the pattern is worked.

This pattern uses UK crochet terminology.

Abbreviations

ch = chain
 chsp = chain space
 dc = double crochet
 rep = repeat
 rnd = round
 slst = slip stitch
 tr = treble

Please Note

As this is an ongoing project, we have not blocked the item so some "waves" and uneven stitching will appear.

Due to the size of the accompanied chart, only a cross section of the stitch layout is shown which is repeated all round.



Instructions

24th rnd: Slst in each of next 2ch, change to **Slate**, 1dc in next ch, (5ch, 1dc in next chsp) around, 2ch, 1tr in first dc.

25th rnd: 1dc in same chsp that closed previous rnd, (9tr in next chsp, 1dc in next chsp) around, omit last dc, slst in first dc.

26th rnd: Slst in each of next 5tr, 3ch (= 1tr), 2tr in same place, *4ch, in centre tr of tr group work 1tr, 3ch, 1tr (= shell), 4ch, work 3tr in centre tr of next tr group, rep from * around, omit last 3tr, slst in top of 3ch.
