Unless yarn specified is used, SAPROTEX cannot accept responsibility for the finished work.
Owing to printing restrictions the colour reproduction is matched as closely to the yarn as possible.
The instructions are given for one size only.
It is advised to read through the pattern before commencing to gain an understanding of how the pattern is worked.
This pattern uses UK crochet terminology.

Abbreviations

ch = chain
chsp = chain space
rep = repeat
rnd = round
slst = slip stitch
tr = treble
yoh = yarn over hook

Special Stitch

trcl = treble cluster: Work 1tr in each of amount stitches indicated leaving last loop of each on hook, yoh and pull through all loops on hook

Please Note

As this was an ongoing project, we had not blocked the item so some "waves" and uneven stitching will appear.
Due to the size of the accompanied chart, only a cross section of the stitch layout is shown which is repeated all round.

Instructions

30th rnd: Using **Slate**, 3ch (= 1tr), 3trcl, *3ch, shell in shell, 5ch, shell in shell, 3ch, 4trcl, rep from * around, omit last 4trcl, slst in first trcl.

31st rnd: Change to **Linen**, slst in chsp, 3ch (= 1tr), 2tr in same chsp, *4tr in next chsp, in next chsp work (5tr, 3ch, slst in last tr, 5tr), 4tr in next chsp, (3tr in next chsp) twice, rep from * around, omit last 3tr, slst in top of 3ch.

Fasten off.

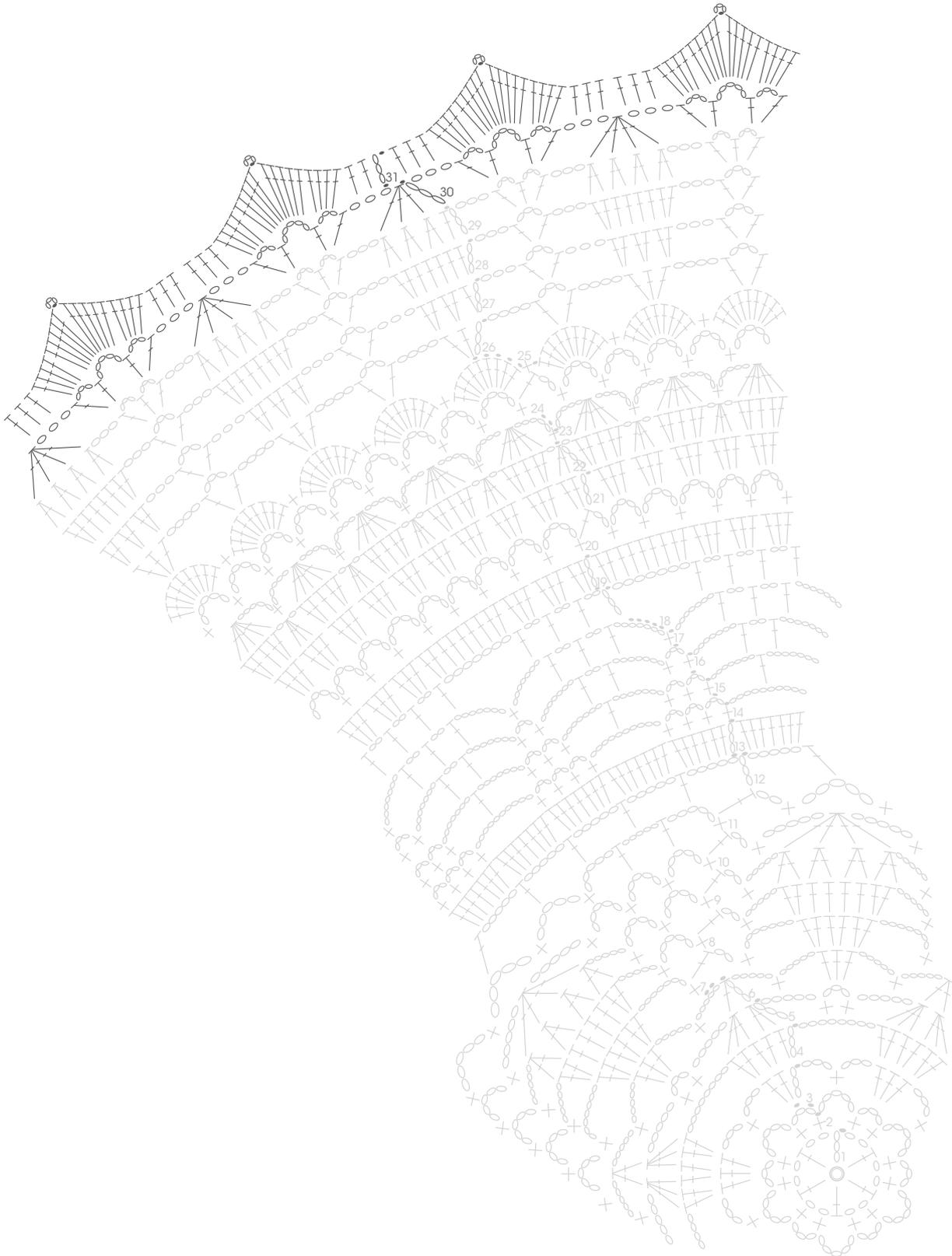
Wet item and remove excess water.

Lay out and block to measurement, leaving to dry.
