The instructions are given for one size only.

It is advised to read through the pattern before commencing to gain an understanding of how the pattern is worked.

## Materials

ELLE FAMILY KNIT VINTAGE DK (100 g ball)

Colour of your choice

We used: Sunkist Coral 242

4 mm crochet hook

## Tension

Is not essential. As long as all squares are worked in an even tension, they should be approximately the same size.

## Abbreviations

This pattern uses UK crochet terminology

| beg = begin(ning)       | rep = repeat         |
| bptr = back post treble | rnd = round          |
| ch = chain              | slst = slip stitch   |
| chsp = chain space      | st(s) = stitch(es)   |
| dc = double crochet     | tog = together       |
| dtr = double treble     | tr = treble          |
| htr = half treble       | yoh = yarn over hook |

## Stitch Explanation

bptr = yoh, insert hook behind stem of treble and complete treble as normal



bobble = (yoh, insert hook in indicated stitch and pull through a loop) 3 times = 7 loops in hook, yoh and pull through 6 loops, yoh and pull through last 2 loops

## Magic Ring



Wrap the yarn twice around your index and middle fingers, insert hook under the strands and pull through a loop. Slip the yarn from your fingers and work one chain stitch to secure the ring. Once you have worked the first round, pull on the shorter end to pull the ring closed.

## Instructions

Using a 4 mm hook beg with a magic ring.

**1<sup>st</sup> rnd:** 1ch (not a st), 12dc in ring, slst in first dc.

**2<sup>nd</sup> rnd:** 6ch (= 1tr and 3ch), \*1tr in next dc, 2tr in next dc, 3ch, 1tr in next dc, 3ch, rep from \* twice more, 1tr in next dc, 2tr in next dc, 3ch, slst in 3<sup>rd</sup> of 6ch.

**3<sup>rd</sup> rnd:** 1ch (= 1dc), \*1dc in each ch st, 1dc in next tr, 3ch, miss 1tr, 1dc in next tr, 1dc in each ch st\*\*, 1dc in next tr, rep from \* around ending at \*\*, slst in beg ch.

**4<sup>th</sup> rnd:** 6ch (= 1tr and 3ch), \*7tr in 3chsp, 3ch, miss 4dc, 1tr in next dc, 3ch, rep from \* twice more, 7tr in 3chsp, 3ch, slst in 3<sup>rd</sup> of 6ch.

**5<sup>th</sup> rnd:** 1ch (= 1dc), 1dc in each ch st and 1dc in each tr around, slst in beg ch = 56dc.

**6<sup>th</sup> rnd:** 7ch (= 1tr and 4ch), \*miss 3dc, 2tr in next dc, 1tr in each of next 5dc, 2tr in next dc, 4ch\*\*, miss 3dc, 1tr in next dc, 4ch, rep from \* around ending at \*\*, slst in 3<sup>rd</sup> of 7ch.

**7<sup>th</sup> rnd:** As 5<sup>th</sup> rnd = 72dc.

**8<sup>th</sup> rnd:** 8ch (= 1tr and 5ch), \*miss 4dc, 2tr in next dc, 1tr in each of next 7dc, 2tr in next dc, 5ch\*\*, miss 4dc, 1tr in next dc, 5ch, rep from \* around ending at \*\*, slst in 3<sup>rd</sup> of 8ch.

**9<sup>th</sup> rnd:** As 5<sup>th</sup> rnd = 88dc.

**10<sup>th</sup> rnd:** 3ch (= 1tr), 1tr in each of next 5dc, \*3ch, 1dtr in each of next 5dc, 3ch, miss 1dc, 1dtr in each of next 5dc, 3ch\*\*, 1tr in each of next 11dc, rep from \* around ending at \*\*, 1tr in each of next 5dc, slst in top of 3ch.

**11<sup>th</sup> rnd:** 3ch (= 1tr), (1bptr around next tr, 1tr in next tr) twice, 1bptr around next tr, \*(7tr in next 3chsp, 1dc in 3<sup>rd</sup> dtr) twice, 7tr in next 3chsp\*\*, (1bptr around next tr, 1tr in next tr) 5 times, 1bptr around next tr, rep from \* around ending at \*\*, (1bptr around next tr, 1tr in next tr) twice, 1bptr around last tr, slst in top of 3ch.

**12<sup>th</sup> rnd:** Slst in next tr, 3ch (= 1tr), (1bptr around next tr, 1tr in next tr) twice, \*3ch, miss 3tr, 1dc in next tr, 7dtr in dc, miss 3tr of next petal, bobble in next tr, 7dtr in next dc, miss 3tr of next petal, 1dc in next tr, 3ch, (1tr in next tr, 1bptr around next tr) 5 times, 1tr in next tr, rep from \* around ending at \*\*, (1tr in next tr, 1bptr around next tr) twice, 1tr in next tr, 1bptr around 3ch, slst in top of 3ch.

**13<sup>th</sup> rnd:** Slst in next tr, 3ch (= 1tr), 1bptr around next tr, 1tr in next tr, 1bptr around next tr, \*1htr in each of next 3ch sts, 1htr in dc, 1htr in each of next 4tr, 1ch, (1dtr, 1ch) 7 times in bobble, miss 3tr of next petal, 1htr in each of next 4tr, 1htr in dc, 1htr in each of next 3ch sts\*\*, (1bptr around next tr, 1tr in next tr) 5 times, 1bptr around next tr, rep from \* around ending at \*\*, (1bptr around next tr, 1tr in next tr) 3 times, 1bptr around 3ch, slst in top of 3ch.

**14<sup>th</sup> rnd:** 1ch (= 1dc), 1dc in each of next 2sts, dc2tog, 1dc in each of next 7sts, \*1dc in 1chsp, missing ch sts work 1dc in each of next 3dtr, 3dc in next dtr, 1dc in each of next 3dtr, 1dc in 1chsp\*\*, 1dc in each of next 7sts, dc2tog, 1dc in each of next 9sts, dc2tog, 1dc in each of next 7sts, rep from \* around ending at \*\*, 1dc in each of next 7sts, dc2tog, 1dc in each of next 6sts, slst in beg ch = 35dc along each edge between corner sts.

Fasten off.

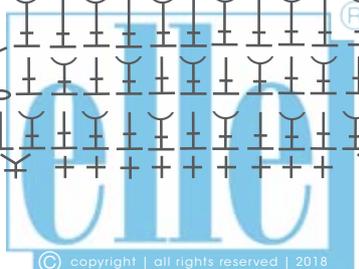
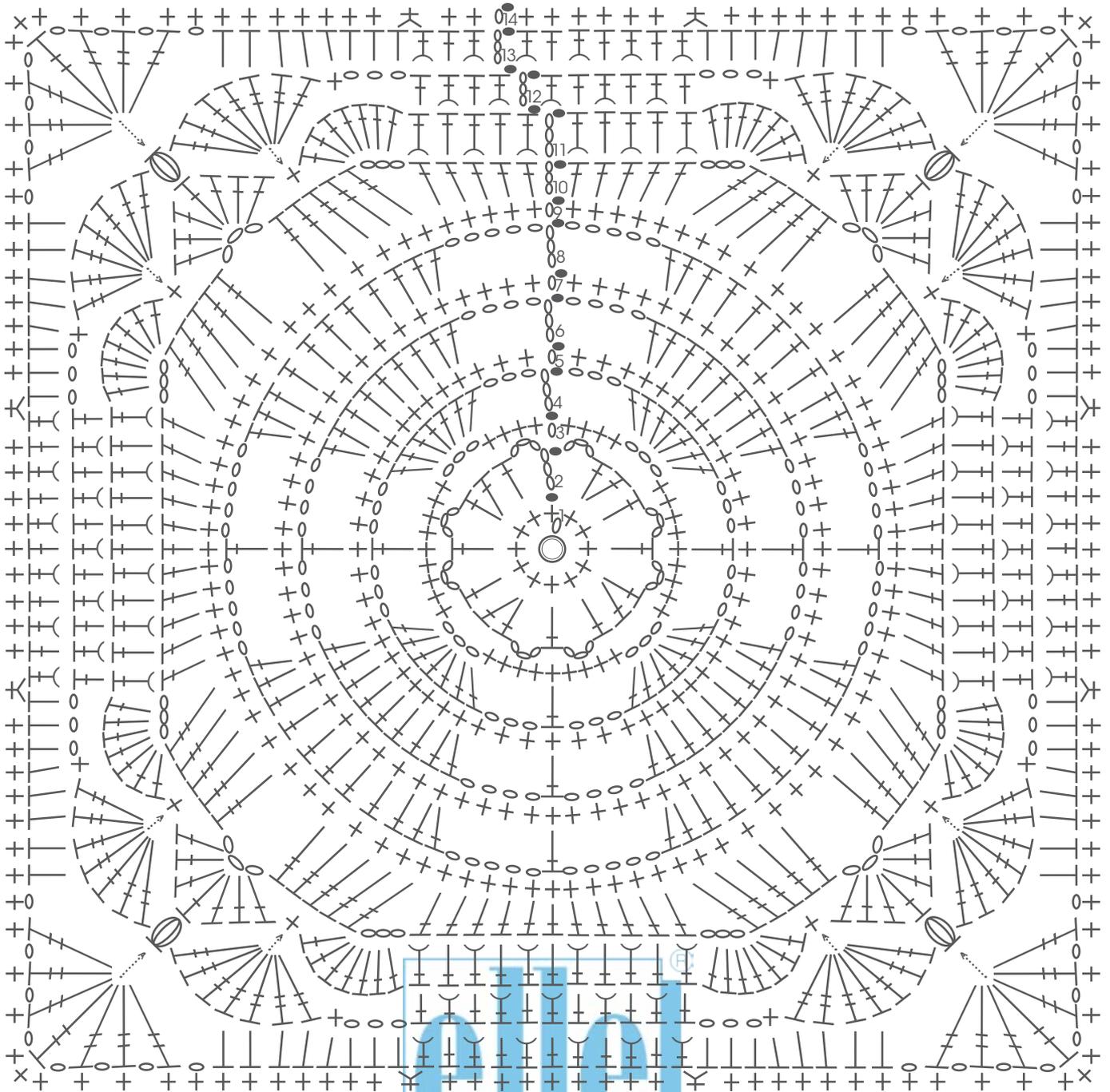
Secure and weave in all ends.

Block square to measurement, cover with a damp cloth and allow to dry.
