ALL SQUARES IN THIS COLLECTION USED A TOTAL OF ±116 G OF YARN:

28 g	20 g	38 g	30 g
Sterling Silver 211	French Grey 251	Cameo 228	Cedar Green 224

Important Note

Unless yarn specified is used, SAPROTEX cannot accept responsibility for the finished work.

Owing to printing restrictions the colour reproduction is matched as closely to the yarn as possible.

The instructions are given for one size only.

It is advised to read through the pattern before commencing to gain an understanding of how the pattern is worked.

Materials

ELLE FAMILY KNIT VINTAGE DK (100 g ball)

4 colours of your choice

We used: Sterling Silver 211, French Grey 251, Cameo 228 and Cedar Green 224

4 mm crochet hook

Tension

Is not essential. As long as all squares are worked in an even tension, they should be approximately the same size.

Abbreviations

This pattern uses UK crochet terminology

beg = begin(ning)	rnd(s) = round(s)
ch = chain	slst = slip stitch
chsp(s) = chain space(s)	sp = space
dc = double crochet	st(s) = stitch(es)
dtr = double treble	tog = together
fol(s) = follow(s)ing	tr(s) = treble(s)
hb = herringbone	ttr = triple treble
rep = repeat	yoh = yarn over hook

Stitch Explanation

hb = yoh, insert hook in indicated stitch and pull through a loop and pull through first loop on hook, yoh and pull through 2 loops on hook

Changing Colour

(#) indicates when to cut yarn and change colour.

Change colour neatly before working last slst to join rounds by inserting hook in indicated stitch, then using next colour, yoh and pull through a loop and pull through stitch on hook

Magic Ring

Wrap the yarn twice around your index and middle fingers, insert hook under the strands and pull through a loop. Slip the yarn from your fingers and work one chain stitch to secure the ring. Once you have worked the first round, pull on the shorter end to pull the ring closed.



Instructions

Using a 4 mm hook and Sterling Silver, make 12ch.

1st row: 1tr in 6th ch from hook, 2ch, miss 2ch, 1tr in next ch, 2ch, miss 2ch, (1tr, 2ch, 1tr) in last ch, turn.

2nd row: 5ch (= 1tr and 2ch), 1tr in first tr, (2ch, 1tr in next tr) 3 times, 2ch, (1tr, 2ch, 1tr) in 3rd of 5ch, turn.

3rd row: 5ch (= 1tr and 2ch), miss first tr, (1tr in next tr, 2ch) 5 times, 1tr in 3rd of 5ch, turn.

4th row: As 3rd row.

5th row: 3ch (= 1tr), (1tr in next tr, 2ch) 4 times, tr2tog by working in next tr and 3rd of 5ch, turn.

6th row: 3ch (= 1tr), (1tr in next tr, 2ch) twice, tr2tog by working in next and foll trs, turn (#).

Now work in rnds.

7th rnd: Using French Grey, 3dc in first 2chsp, *1ch, 3dc in next chsp, rep from * around thus working over the ch sts or tr stems that create a sp ending 1ch, slst in first dc = 48dc, slst in next 2dc, (#) slst in 1chsp.

8th rnd: Using Cameo, 3ch (= 1tr), (1tr, 1ch, 2tr) in same chsp, (2tr, 1ch, 2tr) in each 1chsp around, slst in top of 3ch and next tr.

9th rnd: Slst in 1chsp, 3ch (= 1tr), 3tr in same 1chsp, 4tr in each 1chsp around, (#) slst in top of 3ch.

10th rnd: Using Cedar Green, 1dc in same place as slst, 1dc in each of next 3tr, *1dc in sp between tr of 8th rnd, 1dc in each of next 4tr, rep from * around ending 1dc in last sp between tr and beg 3ch of 8th rnd, (#) slst in first dc.

11th rnd: Using French Grey, 2ch (= 1hb), 1hb in next dc, *1ch, 1hb in each of next 2dc, 1ch**, miss 1dc (= long dc), 1hb in each of next 2dc, rep from * around ending at **, slst in top of 2ch and next hb (#).

12th rnd: Using Cedar Green, slst in 1chsp, 3ch (= 1tr), 3tr in same chsp, *3ch, miss 2hb, next 1ch and next 2hb, (1dc, 1ch, 1dc) in next 1chsp, 3ch**, miss 2hb, next 1ch and next 2hb, 4tr in next 1chsp, rep from * around ending at **, slst in top of 3ch, fasten off.

13th rnd: Using Cameo, slst in any 1chsp between dc of 12th rnd, 3ch (= 1tr), 3tr in same 1chsp, *3ch, working behind 3ch of 12th rnd, 1dc in 11th rnd hb to right of first tr, 3ch behind, 1dc in hb after last tr, 3ch**, 4tr in 1chsp between dc, rep from * around ending at **, (#) slst in top of 3ch.

14th rnd: Using Sterling Silver, 1dc in same place as slst, 1dc in each of next 3tr, *1dc in 13th rnd 3chsp, 1dc in 12th rnd 3chsp, 1dc in each of next 4tr, 1dc in 12th rnd 3chsp, 1dc in 13th rnd 3chsp, 1dc in each of next 4tr, 1dc in 13th rnd 3chsp, 1ch, 1dc in 12th rnd 3chsp, 1dc in each of next 4tr, 1dc in 12th rnd 3chsp, 1ch, 1dc in 13th rnd 3chsp**, 1dc in each of next 4tr, rep from * around ending at **, (#) slst in first dc = 96dc and 8 1chsp.

15th rnd: Using French Grey, 1ch (not a st), 1dc in same place, 1dc in each of next 16dc, *1dc in 1ch, 1dc in each of next 3dc, 8ch, slst in last dc made, 1dc in each of next 3dc, 1dc in 1ch**, 1dc in each of next 18dc, rep from * around ending at **, 1dc in last dc, slst in first dc.

16th rnd: 1ch (= not a st), 1dc in same place, 1dc in each of next 15dc, *(2tr, 2dtr, 3tr, 3ch, 3tr, 2dtr, 2tr) in 8ch loop, miss 5dc, 1dc in each of next 16dc, rep from * twice more, (2tr, 2dtr, 3tr, 3ch, 3tr, 2dtr, 2tr) in 8ch loop, (#) slst in first dc.

17th rnd: Using Sterling Silver, 1ch (not a st), 1dc in same place, *1dc in each st to corner 3chsp, 3dc in 3chsp, rep from * around ending with slst in first dc = 132dc.

18th rnd: 5ch (= 1tr and 2ch), (miss 2dc, 1tr in next dc, 2ch) 7 times, *miss 2dc, 3tr in next dc, (2ch, miss 2dc, 1tr in next dc) 10 times, 2ch, rep from * twice more, miss 2dc, 3tr in next dc, (2ch, miss 2dc, 1tr in next dc) twice, 2ch, slst in 3rd of 5ch.

19th rnd: 2ch (= 1hb), (1hb in each of next 2 ch sts, 1hb in tr) 8 times, *3hb in next tr, (1hb in next tr, 1hb in each of next 2 ch sts) 11 times, 1hb in next tr, rep from * twice more, 3hb in next tr, (1hb in next tr, 1hb in each of next 2 ch sts) 3 times, slst in top of 2ch = 36hb along each edge between corner sts.

Fasten off.



Secure and weave in all ends.

Block square to measurement, cover with a damp cloth and allow to dry.
