ALL SQUARES IN THIS COLLECTION USED A TOTAL OF ±142 G OF YARN:

 The instructions are given for one size only.  
 It is advised to read through the pattern before commencing to gain an understanding of how the pattern is worked.

## Materials

ELLE FAMILY KNIT VINTAGE DK (100 g ball)  
 Colour of your choice  
 We used: ±26 g Hydro Blue 250  
 4 mm crochet hook

## Tension

Is not essential. As long as all squares are worked in an even tension, they should be approximately the same size.

## Abbreviations

This pattern uses UK crochet terminology  
**beg** = begin(ning)                      **rnd** = round  
**bptr** = behind post treble              **slst** = slip stitch  
**ch** = chain                                      **sp** = space  
**chsp** = chain space                      **st(s)** = stitch(es)  
**dc** = double crochet                      **tr** = treble  
**htr** = half treble                              **yoh** = yarn over hook  
**rep** = repeat

## Stitch Explanation

**behind post treble** = yoh, insert hook behind stem of treble and complete treble as normal



**popcorn** = work 5tr in indicated place, remove hook from last tr and insert it in first tr then pick up loop, yoh and pull through all loops on hook  
 {NOTE: For popcorn at beg of rnd, work 3ch, 4tr in indicated place, remove hook and insert into top of 3ch and dropped loop, yoh and pull through loops on hook}  
**v-st** = (1tr, 1ch, 1tr) in indicated place

## Magic Ring

Wrap the yarn twice around your index and middle fingers, insert hook under the strands and pull through a loop. Slip the yarn from your fingers and work one chain stitch to secure the ring. Once you have worked the first round, pull on the shorter end to pull the ring closed.



## *Instructions*

Using a 4 mm hook beg with a magic ring.

**1<sup>st</sup> rnd:** 3ch (= 1tr), 3tr in ring, (3ch, 4tr in ring) 3 times, 3ch, slst in top of 3ch.

**2<sup>nd</sup> rnd:** Slst in next tr, slst in sp between 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> tr, 6ch (= 1tr and 3ch), 1tr in same sp, \*v-st in 3chsp, (1tr, 3ch, 1tr) in sp between 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> tr, rep from \* twice more, v-st in 3chsp, slst in 3<sup>rd</sup> of 6ch.

**3<sup>rd</sup> rnd:** 3ch (= 1tr), \*7tr in 3chsp, 1tr in next tr, v-st in v-st, 1tr in next tr, rep from \* twice more, 7tr in 3chsp, 1tr in next tr, v-st in v-st, slst in top of 3ch.

**4<sup>th</sup> rnd:** 4ch (= 1tr and 1ch), \*(1tr, 1ch) in each of next 7tr, 1tr in next tr, v-st in v-st, 1tr in next tr, 1ch, rep from \* twice more, (1tr, 1ch) in each of next 7tr, 1tr in next tr, v-st in v-st, slst in 3<sup>rd</sup> of 4ch.

**5<sup>th</sup> rnd:** 5ch (= 1bptr and 3ch), (miss next tr, bptr around next tr, 3ch) 3 times, miss next tr, bptr around next tr, \*v-st in v-st, (bptr around next tr, 3ch, miss next tr) 4 times, bptr around next tr, rep from \* twice more, v-st in v-st, slst in 2<sup>nd</sup> of 5ch.

**6<sup>th</sup> rnd:** 6ch (= 1tr and 3ch) 1tr in same place as slst, \*1dc in 3chsp, (3ch, 1dc in next 3chsp) 3 times, (1tr, 3ch, 1tr) in last bptr, v-st in v-st\*\*, (1tr, 3ch, 1tr) in bptr, rep from \* around ending at \*\*, slst in 3<sup>rd</sup> of 6ch.

**7<sup>th</sup> rnd:** 3ch (= 1tr), \*7tr in 3chsp, 1tr in next tr, 1dc in 3chsp, (3ch, 1dc in next 3chsp) twice, 1tr in next tr, 7tr in 3chsp, 1tr in next tr, v-st in v-st\*\*, 1tr in next tr, rep from \* around ending at \*\*, slst in top of 3ch.

**8<sup>th</sup> rnd:** Slst in next 2tr, \*1dc in each of next 6tr, 1ch, 1dc in 3chsp, 3ch, 1dc in next 3chsp, 1ch, 1dc in each of next 6tr, 3ch, miss 3tr, 1tr in v-st, 3ch, miss 3tr, rep from \* around, slst in first dc.

**9<sup>th</sup> rnd:** \*3ch, miss 2dc, 1dc in each of next 3dc, 3ch, miss the dc, 1ch and next dc, 3dc in 3chsp, 3ch, miss the dc, 1ch and next dc, 1dc in each of next 3dc, 3ch, 3dc in 3chsp, 3ch, 1dc in tr, 3ch, 3dc in 3chsp, rep from \* around, slst in first ch.

**10<sup>th</sup> rnd:** 1ch (= 1dc), 1dc in each ch st, 1dc in each dc and 1htr in each corner dc around, slst in beg ch = 136sts.

**11<sup>th</sup> rnd:** Slst in next dc, 1dc in next dc, (3ch, popcorn in same st as dc, miss 3dc, 1dc in next dc) 6 times, \*3ch, miss htr, 1dc in next dc, (3ch, popcorn in same st as dc, miss 3dc, 1dc in next dc) 8 times, rep from \* twice more, 3ch, miss htr, 1dc in next dc, 3ch, popcorn in same st as dc, miss 3dc, 1dc in next dc, 3ch, popcorn in same st as dc, slst in first dc.

**12<sup>th</sup> rnd:** 3ch (= 1tr), \*[(1htr, 2dc) in 3chsp, 1tr in next dc] to corner 3chsp, (2tr, 1ch, 2tr) in corner 3chsp, 1tr in next dc, rep from \* around ending slst in top of 3ch.

**13<sup>th</sup> rnd:** 1dc in next st, (1ch, miss 1 st, 1dc in next st) to corner, \*1ch, 1dc in corner 1chsp, (1ch, miss 1 st, 1dc in next st) to next corner, rep from \* around ending 1ch, slst in first dc.

**14<sup>th</sup> rnd:** 1ch (= 1dc), 1dc in each ch st, 1dc in each dc and 3dc in each cornerdc around, slst in beg ch = 39dc along each edge between corner sts.



Fasten off.

Secure and weave in all ends.

Block square to measurement, cover with a damp cloth and allow to dry.
