Caviar 017	French Grey 251	Champagne Beige 225	Deep Mahogany 271

Owing to printing restrictions the colour reproduction is matched as closely to the yarn as possible.
The instructions are given for one size only.
It is advised to read through the pattern before commencing to gain an understanding of how the pattern is worked.

Materials

ELLE FAMILY KNIT VINTAGE DK (100 g ball)
4 colours of your choice
We used: Champagne Beige 225, Deep Mahogany 271, French Grey 251 and Caviar 017
4 mm crochet hook

Tension

Is not essential. As long as all squares are worked in an even tension, they should be approximately the same size.

Abbreviations

- This pattern uses UK crochet terminology
- beg = begin(ning)
 - bpdc = behind post double crochet
 - ch = chain
 - chsp = chain space
 - dc = double crochet
 - dtr = double treble
 - fcdc = front post double crochet
 - fpht = front post half treble
 - htr = half treble
 - mb = mini bullion
 - rem = remain(ing)
 - rep = repeat
 - rnd = round
 - slst = slip stitch
 - sp = space
 - st(s) = stitch(es)
 - tr = treble
 - yoh = yarn over hook

Stitch Explanation



b(f)cdc = insert hook behind(in front of) stem of stitch and work a double crochet as normal
fpht = yoh, insert hook in front of stem of stitch and complete a half treble as normal
mini bullion (mb) = yoh 3 times (*not too tight*), insert hook in indicated place and pull through a loop (= 5 loops on hook), pull hook through last 4 loops on hook (*you may find it easier to use your other hand to "pull" the loops away from the hook when pulling the hook through*)
picot = 3 chain, slip stitch in first chain
popcorn = work 4 treble in indicated place, remove hook and insert into first treble and dropped loop, yoh and pull through loops on hook
{NOTE: For popcorn at beg of rnd, work 3ch, 3tr in indicated place, remove hook and insert into top of 3ch and dropped loop, yoh and pull through loops on hook}

Changing Colour

(#) indicates when to cut yarn and change colour.
Change colour neatly before working last slst to join rounds by inserting hook in indicated stitch, then using next colour, yoh and pull through a loop and pull through stitch on hook

Magic Ring



Wrap the yarn twice around your index and middle fingers, insert hook under the strands and pull through a loop. Slip the yarn from your fingers and work one chain stitch to secure the ring. Once you have worked the first round, pull on the shorter end to pull the ring closed.

Instructions

Using a 4 mm hook and French Grey, beg with a magic ring.

1st rnd: 8dc in ring, slst in first dc.

2nd rnd: 3ch (= 1tr) 1tr in same dc, 2tr in each dc around, (#) slst in top of 3ch = 16tr.

3rd rnd: Using Caviar 1ch (= 1dc), mb in same st as 1ch, (1dc, mb) in next dc around, (#) slst in beg ch.

4th rnd: Using French Grey 1dc in same place as slst, (2ch, miss mb, 1dc in next dc) around, 2ch, slst in first dc (#).

5th rnd: Using Deep Mahogany slst in 2chsp, popcorn in same chsp, (6ch, miss next 2chsp, popcorn in next 2chsp) 7 times, 6ch, miss next 2chsp, slst in first popcorn.

Fasten off.

6th rnd: Using Champagne Beige and working behind previous rnd, slst in any missed 2chsp, 3ch (= 1tr), (1tr, 2ch, 2tr) in same 2chsp, *1ch, (2tr, 2ch, 2tr) in next missed 2chsp, rep from * 6 times more, 1ch, slst in top of 3ch.

7th rnd: *1dc in popcorn, working over 6ch of 5th rnd (2tr, 1dtr, picot, 1dtr, 2tr) in 2chsp, rep from * around (#), slst in first dc.

8th rnd: Using French Grey *7ch, slst in same dc, fpdc around each of next 3sts, slst in back loop of first picot ch, 5ch, slst in back loop of last picot ch, fpdc around each of next 3sts, slst in next dc, rep from * around, placing last slst at base of 7ch, slst in next 3ch sts (#).

9th rnd: Using Caviar slst in 7chsp, 7ch (= 1tr and 4ch), 1tr in same chsp, *3ch, working behind 8th rnd, 1dc in picot sp, 3ch**, (1tr, 4ch, 1tr) in next 7chsp, rep from * around ending at ** (#), slst in 3rd of 7ch.

10th rnd: Using Champagne Beige *4ch, slst in next tr, 3ch, 1dc in dc, 3ch, slst in next tr, 7ch, slst in next tr, 3ch, 1dc in dc, 3ch, slst in next tr, rep from * around placing last slst in same place as beg 4ch.

11th rnd: *5dc in 4chsp, 4dc in 3chsp, 1dc in 5chsp of 8th rnd, 4dc in 3chsp, 9dc in 7chsp, 4dc in 3chsp, 1dc in 5chsp of 8th rnd, 4dc in 3chsp, rep from * around (#), slst in first dc = 128dc.

12th rnd: Using Deep Mahogany 1dc in each of next 9dc, *bpdc around next dc, miss 4dc, 2dtr in next dc, (1dtr, 1tr) in next dc, 2tr in next dc, 1tr in next dc, (1tr, 2ch, 1tr) in next dc, 1tr in next dc, 2tr in next dc, (1tr, 1dtr) in next dc, 2dtr in next dc, miss 4dc, bpdc around next dc**, 1dc in each of next 13dc, rep from * around ending at **, 1dc in each of next 4dc, slst in first dc.

Fasten off.

13th rnd: Using Champagne Beige *slst in dc before bpdc at corner petal, bpdc around bpdc, 1fpht around each of next 8sts, (1htr, 2ch, 1htr) in 2chsp, 1fpht around each of next 8sts, bpdc around bpdc, fasten off. Rep from * for rem 3 corners.

14th rnd: Using French Grey slst in 2nd dc of 12th rnd from fastened off dc, 1ch (= 1dc), 1dc in each of next 2dc, *1htr in each of next 2dc, 5ch, miss 5sts, 1dc in each of next 7sts, (1dc, 2ch, 1dc) in corner 2chsp, 1dc in each of next 7sts, 5ch, miss 5sts, 1htr in each of next 2dc**, 1dc in each of next 5dc, rep from * around ending at **, 1dc in each of next 2dc, slst in beg ch.

15th rnd: 1ch (= 1dc), working in back loops 1dc in each of next 17sts, *(1dc, 1ch, 1dc) in corner 2chsp, working in back loops 1dc in each of next 35sts, rep from * twice more, (1dc, 1ch, 1dc) in corner 2chsp, working in back loops 1dc in each of next 17sts, slst in beg ch.

16th rnd: 1ch (= 1dc), working in back loops 1dc in each of next 18sts, *(1dc, 1ch, 1dc) in corner 1chsp, working in back loop 1dc in each of next 37sts, rep from * twice more, (1dc, 1ch, 1dc) in corner 1chsp, working in back loops 1dc in each of next 18sts, (#) slst in beg ch.

17th rnd: Using Champagne Beige 1ch (= 1dc), 1dc in back loop of next dc, *(1dtr in front loop of 15th rnd corresponding dc, 1dc each in back loop of next 4dc) 3 times, 1dtr in front loop of 15th rnd corresponding dc, 1dc each in back loop of next 2dc, (1dc, 1ch, 1dc) in corner 1chsp, 1dc each in back loop of next 2dc, (1dtr in front loop of 15th rnd corresponding dc, 1dc each in back loop of next 4dc) 3 times, 1dtr in front loop of 15th rnd corresponding dc**, 1dc each in back loop of next 3dc, rep from * around ending at **, 1dc in back loop of last dc, slst in beg ch.

18th rnd: 1ch (= 1dc), working in back loops 1dc in each of next 20sts, *(1dc, 1ch, 1dc) in corner 1chsp, working in back loops 1dc in each of next 41sts, rep from * twice more, (1dc, 1ch, 1dc) in corner 1chsp, working in back loops 1dc in each of next 20sts, (#) slst in beg ch.

19th rnd: Using Deep Mahogany 1ch (= 1dc), 1dc in back loop of next dc, *(mb in front loop of 18th rnd corresponding dc, 1dc each in back loop of next 4dc) 4 times, mb in corner 1chsp, (1dc each in back loop of next 4dc, mb in front loop of 18th rnd corresponding dc) 4 times**, 1dc each in back loop of next 3dc, rep from * around ending at **, 1dc in back loop of last dc, (#) slst in beg ch.

20th rnd: Using Caviar 2ch (= 1fpht), 1fpht around next dc, *(1dc in back loop of mb, 1fpht around each of next 4dc) 4 times, 3dc in back loop of corner mb, (1fpht around each of next 4dc, 1dc in back loop of mb) 4 times**, 1fpht around each of next 3dc, rep from * around ending at **, 1fpht around last dc, slst in top of 2ch = 45sts along each edge between corner sts.


















Fasten off.

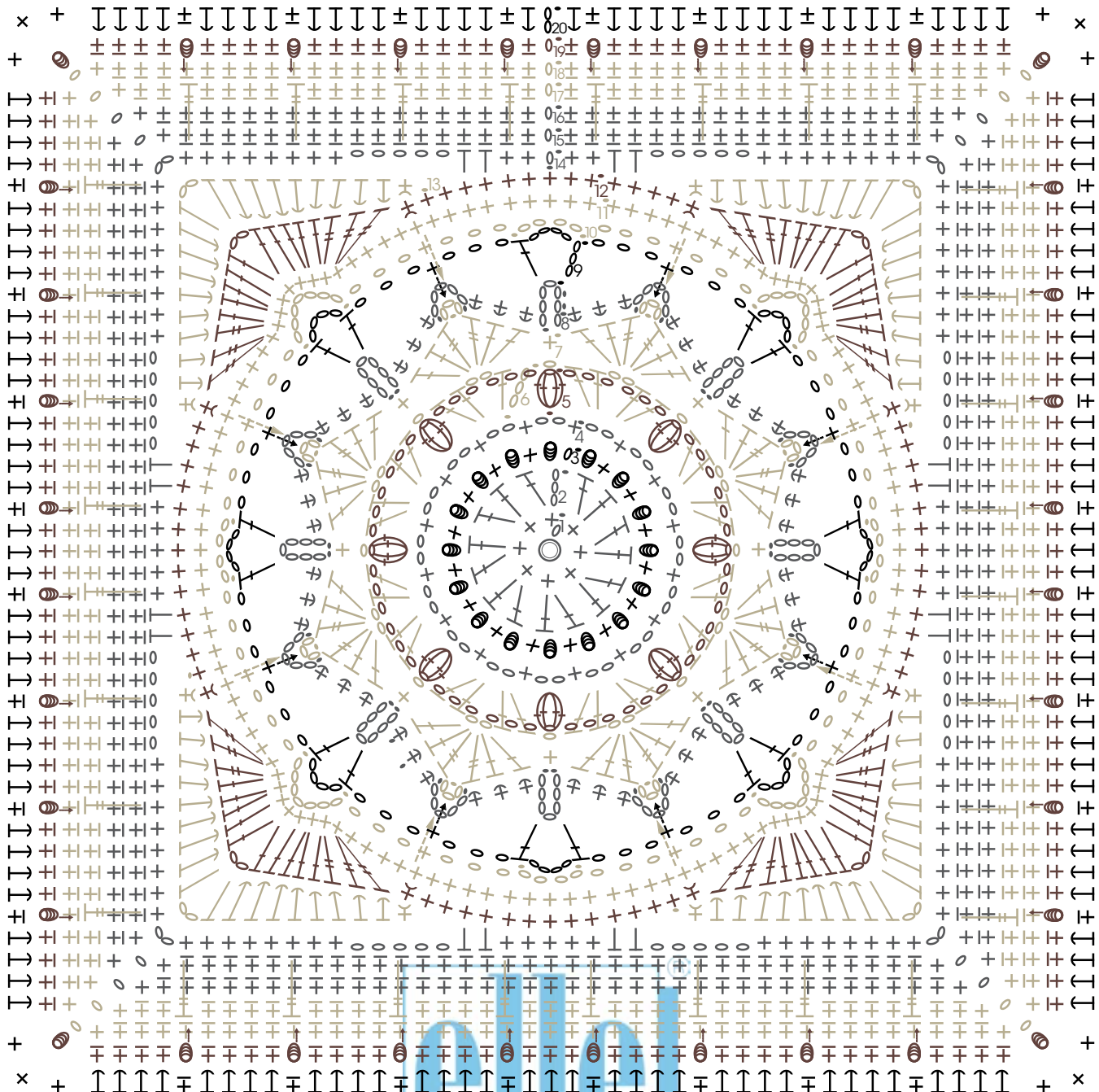
Secure and weave in all ends.

Block square to measurement, cover with a damp cloth and allow to dry.
