## Important Note

Unless yarn specified is used, SAPROTEX cannot accept responsibility for the finished work.

Owing to printing restrictions the colour reproduction is matched as closely to the yarn as possible.

The instructions are given for one size only.

It is advised to read through the pattern before commencing to gain an understanding of how the pattern is worked.

## Special Abbreviation

**MB** = make bobble: (K1, p1, k1, p1, k1) in next stitch, turn work and p5sts, turn work and pass the 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> stitch (one at a time) over 1<sup>st</sup> stitch, then knit into the back of first stitch

## Stitch Explanation

The yarn forward (yfd), yarn over needle (yon) and yarn around needle (yrn) all serve the same purpose - to make a stitch to correspond with the stitch(es) that is(are) lost when working a decrease. They are just worked slightly differently dependent on where they are placed in the pattern and what stitch follows:

**Yarn forward (yfd)** = is worked before or after any knit stitches by simply bringing the working yarn to the front of the work.

**Yarn over needle (yon)** = is worked after a purl stitch before the next knit stitch. As the working yarn is already in front of the work from working a purl stitch, take yarn to back of work, then wrap the needle again, thus having a loop over the needle and the working yarn again at back of work.

**\*Note\***: On following rows you will need to work into the back loop of the yon to make the eyelet hole.

**Yarn around needle (yrn)** = is worked before a purl stitch. If the yarn is at the back of the work from working a knit stitch, bring yarn to front of work, then wrap the needle again, thus having a loop around the needle and the working yarn again in front of work. If the yarn is at the front of the work from working a purl stitch, wrap the needle again, thus having a loop around the needle and the working yarn again in front of work.

## Materials

ELLE PURE GOLD DK (100 g ball)

2 balls in colour of your choice: We used Parakeet 076

One pair 4 mm knitting needles

## Tension

Is not essential. As long as all squares are worked in an even tension, they should be approximately the same size.

## Abbreviations

k = knit

kb = knit into back of stitch

MB = make bobble (see special abbreviation)

p = purl

patf = pattern

pb = purl into back of stitch

RSF = right side facing

st(s) = stitch(es)

tbl = through back of loop(s)

tog = together

yfd = yarn forward

yon = yarn over needle

yrn = yarn around needle

# Knit-a-Long | Square Six

## Instructions

Using 4 mm needles cast on 55sts.

1<sup>st</sup> row: RSE, k1, (p1, k1) to end.

2<sup>nd</sup> row: As 1<sup>st</sup> row.

3<sup>rd</sup> row: K1, p1, k to last 2sts, p1, k1.

4<sup>th</sup> row: K1, p18, k2, pb, k2, p7, k2, pb, k2, p to last st, k1.

5<sup>th</sup> row: K1, p1, k17, p2, kb, p2, k7, p2, kb, p2, k to last 2sts, p1, k1.

6<sup>th</sup> row: K1, p20, pb, k2, p7, k2, pb, p to last st, k1.

7<sup>th</sup> row: K1, p1, k17, p17, k to last 2sts, p1, k1.

8<sup>th</sup> row: K1, p18, k17, p to last st, k1.

9<sup>th</sup> row: K1, p1, k20, p2, k7, p2, k to last 2sts, p1, k1.

10<sup>th</sup> row: As 6<sup>th</sup> row.

11<sup>th</sup> row: As 9<sup>th</sup> row.

12<sup>th</sup> row: K1, p21, k2, p2, k3, p2, k2, p to last st, k1.

13<sup>th</sup> row: K1, p1, k8, p2, kb, p11, k2, p3, k2, p11, kb, p2, k8, p1, k1.

14<sup>th</sup> row: K1, p9, k2, pb, k11, p2, k3, p2, k11, pb, k2, p9, k1.

15<sup>th</sup> row: K1, p1, k20, p2, k2, p3, k2, p2, k to last 2sts, p1, k1.

16<sup>th</sup> row: K1, p21, k2, p7, k2, p to last st, k1.

17<sup>th</sup> row: K1, p1, k7, kb, p1, kb, k10, p2, k7, p2, k10, kb, p1, kb, k7, p1, k1.

18<sup>th</sup> row: K1, p8, pb, k1, pb, p10, k2, p7, k2, p10, pb, k1, pb, p8, k1.

19<sup>th</sup> row: K1, p1, k7, kb, p1, kb, k7, p17, k7, kb, p1, kb, k7, p1, k1.

20<sup>th</sup> row: K1, p8, pb, k1, pb, p7, k17, p7, pb, k1, pb, p8, k1.

21<sup>st</sup> row: K1, p1, k7, kb, p1, kb, k9, kb, p2, k7, p2, kb, k9, kb, p1, kb, k7, p1, k1.

22<sup>nd</sup> row: K1, p8, pb, k1, pb, p7, k2, pb, k2, p7, k2, pb, k2, p7, pb, k1, pb, p8, k1.

23<sup>rd</sup> row: K1, p1, k7, kb, p1, kb, k7, p2, kb, p2, k7, p2, kb, p2, k7, kb, p1, kb, k7, p1, k1.

24<sup>th</sup> row: K1, p8, pb, k1, pb, p31, pb, k1, pb, p8, k1.

25<sup>th</sup> row: K1, p1, k7, kb, p1, kb, k31, kb, p1, kb, k7, p1, k1.

26<sup>th</sup> row: K1, p1, k2, pb, k2, p2, pb, k1, pb, p2, k2, pb, k2, p17, (k2, pb) twice, p2, k1, pb, p2, k2, pb, k2, p1, k1.

27<sup>th</sup> row: K1, p3, kb, p2, k2, kb, p1, kb, k2, p2, kb, p2, k6, (MB, k1) twice, MB, k6, p2, kb, p2, k2, kb, p1, kb, k2, p2, kb, p3, k1.

28<sup>th</sup> row: K1, p3, pb, k2, p2, pb, k1, pb, p2, k2, pb, p21, pb, k2, p2, pb, k1, pb, p2, k2, pb, p3, k1.

29<sup>th</sup> row: K1, p18, k4, MB, k7, MB, k4, p to last st, k1.

30<sup>th</sup> row: K1, p1, k17, p17, k to last 2sts, p1, k1.

31<sup>st</sup> row: K1, p1, k3, p2, k7, p2, k6, MB, k2, (yfd, k2tog) 3 times, k1, MB, k6, p2, k7, p2, k3, p1, k1.

32<sup>nd</sup> row: K1, p4, k2, p7, k2, p9, (k1, p1) twice, k1, p9, k2, p7, k2, p4, k1.

33<sup>rd</sup> row: K1, p1, k3, p2, k7, p2, k5, MB, k1, k2togtbl, yfd, (k1, p1) twice, k1, yfd, k2tog, k1, MB, k5, p2, k7, p2, k3, p1, k1.

34<sup>th</sup> row: K1, p4, k2, p2, k3, p2, k2, p9, (k1, p1) twice, k1, p9, k2, p2, k3, p2, k2, p4, k1.

35<sup>th</sup> row: K1, p1, k3, p2, k2, p3, k2, p2, k4, MB, k1, k2togtbl, yrn, (p1, k1) 3 times, p1, yon, k2tog, k1, MB, k4, p2, k2, p3, k2, p2, k3, p1, k1.

36<sup>th</sup> row: K1, p4, k2, p2, k3, p2, k2, p7, (k1, p1) 4 times, k1, p7, k2, p2, k3, p2, k2, p4, k1.

37<sup>th</sup> row: As 35<sup>th</sup> row.

38<sup>th</sup> row: As 34<sup>th</sup> row.

39<sup>th</sup> row: K1, p1, k3, p2, k7, p2, k5, MB, k1, k2tog, yfd, (k1, p1) twice, k1, yfd, k2togtbl, k1, MB, k5, p2, k7, p2, k3, p1, k1.

40<sup>th</sup> row: As 32<sup>nd</sup> row.

41<sup>st</sup> row: K1, p1, k3, p2, k7, p2, k6, MB, k1, (k2tog, yfd) 3 times, k2, MB, k6, p2, k7, p2, k3, p1, k1.

42<sup>nd</sup> row: As 30<sup>th</sup> row.

43<sup>rd</sup> row: As 29<sup>th</sup> row.

44<sup>th</sup> row: As 28<sup>th</sup> row.

45<sup>th</sup> row: As 27<sup>th</sup> row.

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46<sup>th</sup> row: As 26<sup>th</sup> row.

47<sup>th</sup> row: As 25<sup>th</sup> row.

48<sup>th</sup> row: As 24<sup>th</sup> row.

49<sup>th</sup> row: As 23<sup>rd</sup> row.

50<sup>th</sup> row: As 22<sup>nd</sup> row.

51<sup>st</sup> row: As 21<sup>st</sup> row.

52<sup>nd</sup> row: As 20<sup>th</sup> row.

53<sup>rd</sup> row: As 19<sup>th</sup> row.

54<sup>th</sup> row: As 18<sup>th</sup> row.

55<sup>th</sup> row: As 17<sup>th</sup> row.

56<sup>th</sup> row: As 16<sup>th</sup> row.

57<sup>th</sup> row: As 15<sup>th</sup> row.

58<sup>th</sup> row: As 14<sup>th</sup> row.

59<sup>th</sup> row: As 13<sup>th</sup> row.

60<sup>th</sup> row: As 12<sup>th</sup> row.

61<sup>st</sup> row: As 9<sup>th</sup> row.

62<sup>nd</sup> row: As 16<sup>th</sup> row.

63<sup>rd</sup> row: As 9<sup>th</sup> row.

64<sup>th</sup> row: As 8<sup>th</sup> row.

65<sup>th</sup> row: As 7<sup>th</sup> row.

66<sup>th</sup> row: As 6<sup>th</sup> row.

67<sup>th</sup> row: As 5<sup>th</sup> row.

68<sup>th</sup> row: As 4<sup>th</sup> row.

69<sup>th</sup> row: As 3<sup>rd</sup> row.

70<sup>th</sup> row: As 1<sup>st</sup> row.

Cast off all sts in patt as worked for 70<sup>th</sup> row.

Block square to measurement, cover with a damp cloth and allow to dry.
