Owing to printing restrictions the colour reproduction is matched as closely to the yarn as possible.

The instructions are given for one size only.

It is advised to read through the pattern before commencing to gain an understanding of how the pattern is worked.

yfd = yarn forward

yon = yarn over needle

yrn = yarn around needle

## Special Abbreviations

**C2B** = knit into back of second st on left hand needle, then knit first st, slipping both sts of the needle together

**C2F** = knit in front of second st on left hand needle, then knit first st, slipping both sts off the needle together

**C3B** = slip next stitch onto cable needle and hold at back of work, k2sts from left hand needle, then k1 st from cable needle

**C3F** = slip next 2sts onto cable needle and hold at front of work, k1 st from left hand needle, then k2sts from cable needle

**C4B(F)** = slip next 2sts onto cable needle and hold at back(front) of work, k2sts from left hand needle, then k2sts from cable needle

**C5F** = slip next 3sts onto cable needle and hold at front of work, k2sts from left hand needle, slip the purl stitch (= 3<sup>rd</sup> on cable needle) back onto left hand needle and purl this stitch, then k2sts from cable needle

**T3B** = slip next stitch onto cable needle and hold at back of work, k2sts from left hand needle, then p1 st from cable needle

**T3F** = slip next 2sts onto cable needle and hold at front of work, p1 st from left hand needle, then k2sts from cable needle

**T4Btog** = slip next 2sts onto a cable needle and hold at back of work, k2sts from left hand needle, then p2tog from cable needle

**T4Ftog** = slip next 2sts onto cable needle and hold at front of work, p2tog from left hand needle, then k2sts from cable needle

**T4Ltog** = slip next stitch to RHN, slip next 2sts onto cable needle and hold at front of work, slip the stitch on RHN back to LHN and p2tog, then k2 from cable needle

**T4Rtog** = slip next stitch to RHN, slip next 2sts onto cable needle and hold at front of work, slip the stitch on RHN back to left hand needle, k2 from cable needle, then p2tog from left hand needle

## Materials

ELLE PURE GOLD DK (100 g)

2 balls colour of your choice: We used Parakeet 076

One pair 4 mm knitting needles

Cable needle

## Tension

Is not essential. As long as all squares are worked in an even tension, they should be approximately the same size.

## Abbreviations

dec = decrease

inc = increase

k = knit

m1 = make one stitch, pick up loop between last and next stitch and work into the back of this loop

p = purl

patt = pattern

rep = repeat

RSF = right side facing

SKPO = slip one, knit one, pass slipped stitch over

SKTPO = slip one, knit two together, pass slipped stitch over

st(s) = stitch(es)

tog = together

# Knit-a-Long | Square Nine

## Special Stitch

**star** = p3tog, leaving stitches on needle, yarn around needle, then purl the same 3sts again

## Stitch Explanation

The yarn forward (yfd), yarn over needle (yon) and yarn around needle (yrn) all serve the same purpose – to make a stitch to correspond with the stitch(es) that is(are) lost when working a k2tog or a SKPO(SKTPO). They are just worked slightly differently dependent on where they are placed in the pattern and what stitch follows:

**Yarn forward (yfd)** = is worked before or after any knit stitches by simply bringing the working yarn to the front of the work.

**Yarn over needle (yon)** = is worked after a purl stitch before the next knit stitch. As the working yarn is already in front of the work from working a purl stitch, take yarn to back of work, then wrap the needle again, thus having a loop over the needle and the working yarn again at back of work.

\*Note\*: On following rows you will need to work into the back loop of the yon to make the eyelet hole.

**Yarn around needle (yrn)** = is worked before a purl stitch. If the last stitch worked was a knit stitch, bring yarn to front of work, then wrap the needle again, thus having a loop around the needle and the working yarn again in front of work.

If the last stitch was a purl stitch, then wrap the needle again, thus having a loop around the needle and the working yarn again in front of work.

## Instructions

Using 4 mm needles cast on 53sts.

**1<sup>st</sup> row:** RSF, k1, (p1, k1) to end.

**2<sup>nd</sup> row:** As 1<sup>st</sup> row.

**3<sup>rd</sup> row:** K1, p1, k to last 2sts, p1, k1.

**4<sup>th</sup> row:** K1, p to last st, k1.

**5<sup>th</sup> row:** As 3<sup>rd</sup> row.

**6<sup>th</sup> row:** K1, p6, (star, p1) 9 times, star, p6, k1.

**7<sup>th</sup> row:** As 3<sup>rd</sup> row.

**8<sup>th</sup> row:** K1, p2, star, p to last 6sts, star, p2, k1.

**9<sup>th</sup> row:** As 3<sup>rd</sup> row.

**10<sup>th</sup> row:** As 6<sup>th</sup> row.

**11<sup>th</sup> row:** As 3<sup>rd</sup> row.

**12<sup>th</sup> row, inc row:** K1, p2, star, p2, m1, p8, (m1, p7) 3 times, m1, p8, m1, p2, star, p2, k1 = 59sts.

**13<sup>th</sup> row:** K1, p1, k5, p1, C4F, p5, k4, p4, k4, p1, k4, p4, k4, p5, C4F, p1, k5, p1, k1.

**14<sup>th</sup> row:** K1, p6, k1, p4, k5, p4, k4, p4, k1, p4, k4, p4, k5, p4, k1, p6, k1.

**15<sup>th</sup> row:** K1, p1, k5, p1, k4, p5, C4B, p4, C4B, p1, C4F, p4, C4B, p5, k4, p1, k5, p1, k1.

60<sup>th</sup> row: K1, p2, (star, p1) to last 2sts, p1, k1.

61<sup>st</sup> row: As 3<sup>rd</sup> row.

62<sup>nd</sup> row: As 4<sup>th</sup> row.

63<sup>rd</sup> row: As 3<sup>rd</sup> row.

64<sup>th</sup> to 67<sup>th</sup> row: Rep 60<sup>th</sup> to 63<sup>rd</sup> row.

68<sup>th</sup> row: As 1<sup>st</sup> row.

Cast off all sts in patt as worked for last row.

Block square to measurement, cover with a damp cloth and allow to dry.

## Joining the Squares

Arrange the squares as shown on next page or in your own desired position.

All squares were joined by sewing on reverse side, evenly and neatly.



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
