MATERIALS

ELLE FAMILY KNIT CHUNKY (50 g ball)
Silver 317 (A), Black 017 (B) and White 001 (C)
One pair 5,5 mm knitting needles

beg = begin(ning)
cont = continue

INSTRUCTIONS

Make 4:

[Note: If you are doing panels, work to *]

Using 5,5 mm needles and B, cast on 36(42;46)sts.
Working 1 row each B, C and A throughout, cont as follows:

1st row: RSF, k1, (yfd, sl1pw, yb, k1) to last st, k1.

2nd row: P1, (yb, sl1pw, yfd, p1) to last st, p1.

Rep these 2 rows until work measures 19(22;25)cm ending with a WSR worked in B.*

Cut off A and C and cont in B, working 1st row once more.

Cast off all sts knitwise.

IF YOU ARE JOINING SQUARES BY CONTINUING TO KNIT, DO NOT CAST OFF BUT FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS BELOW INTO NEXT SQUARE FOR RESPECTIVE PANELS.

PANEL 1 & 7:

Next row: Using B, k5(2;1)sts, [inc in next st, k1(2;2)sts] 12(12;14) times, inc in next st, k6(3;2)sts = 49(55;61)sts.

Beg with 2nd row of BRAID STITCH SQUARE and foll patt.

IMPORTANT NOTE

Unless yarn specified is used, SAPROTEX cannot accept responsibility for the finished work.

Owing to printing restrictions the colour reproduction is matched as closely to the yarn as possible.

The instructions are given for the smallest size, with the larger sizes in brackets; where only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

It is advised to read through the pattern before commencing to gain an understanding of how the pattern is worked.

Tension is not essential to achieve success for this project. If all squares are worked in an even tension, they should be approximately the same size.



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
