Unless yarn specified is used, SAPROTEX cannot accept responsibility for the finished work.

Owing to printing restrictions the colour reproduction is matched as closely to the yarn as possible.

The instructions are given for the smallest size, with the larger sizes in brackets; where only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

It is advised to read through the pattern before commencing to gain an understanding of how the pattern is worked.

Tension is not essential to achieve success for this project. If all squares are worked in an even tension, they should be approximately the same size.

MATERIALS

ELLE FAMILY KNIT CHUNKY (50 g ball)

One pair 5,5 mm knitting needles

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning)

foll(s) = follow(s)ing

inc = increase

k = knit

p = purl

patt = pattern

rep = repeat

RW = ribwise

R(W)SF = right(wrong) side facing

sl = slip

st(s) = stitch(es)

tog = together

WSR = wrong side row

INSTRUCTIONS

Make 3:

[Note: Slip all stitches purlwise. If you are doing panels, work to *.]

Using 5,5 mm needles and first colour, cast on 33(37;43)sts.

1st row: RSF, sl0(2;0)sts, k4, (sl1, k3, sl1, k5) to last 9(11;9)sts, sl1, k3, sl1, k4(6;4)sts.

2nd row: Sl0(2;0)sts, p4, (sl1, p3, sl1, p5) to last 9(11;9)sts, sl1, p3, sl1, p4(6;4)sts.

3rd row: Using second colour, sl0(2;0)sts, k3, (sl1, k5, sl1, k3) to last 0(2;0)sts, k0(2;0)sts.

4th row: Sl0(2;0)sts, p3, (sl1, p5, sl1, p3) to last 0(2;0)sts, p0(2;0)sts.



VERSA TILE

KNIT-A-LONG

FREE PATTERN CODE: 20.011

5th row: Using first colour, sl0(2;0)sts, k1, sl2, k7, (sl3, k7) to last 3(5;3)sts, sl2, k1(3;1)sts.

6th row: Sl0(2;0)sts, p1, sl2, p7, (sl3, p7) to last 3(5;3)sts, sl3, p1(3;1)sts.

7th row: Using second colour, sl0(2;0)sts, k3, (sl1, k5, sl1, k3) to last 0(2;0)sts, k0(2;0)sts.

8th row: Sl0(2;0)sts, p3, (sl1, p5, sl1, p3) to last 0(2;0)sts, p0(2;0)sts.

9th row: Using first colour, as 1st row.

10th row: As 2nd row.

11th row: Using second colour, sl0(2;0)sts, k5, (sl3, k7) to last *(10;8)sts, sl3, k5(7;5)sts.

12th row: Sl0(2;0)sts, p5, (sl3, p7) to last 8(10;8)sts, sl3, p5(7;5)sts.

Rep these 12 rows until work measures $\pm 19(22;25)$ cm ending with a WSR.*

Cast off all sts.

IF YOU ARE JOINING SQUARES BY CONTINUING TO KNIT, DO NOT CAST OFF BUT FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS BELOW INTO NEXT SQUARE FOR RESPECTIVE PANELS.

PANEL 3:

Next row: Using A, inc in first st, [k15(8;20)sts, inc in next st] 2(4;2) times = 36(42;46)sts.

Beg with 2nd row of LINEN STITCH SQUARE and foll patt.
