Make 7(10;17) motifs

Owing to printing restrictions the colour reproduction is matched as closely to the yarn as possible.

The instructions are given for one size only.

It is advised to read through the pattern before commencing to gain an understanding of how the pattern is worked.

## TRIPOLI

### MATERIALS

ELLE SHOWCASE (100 g ball)

To make 6 triangles = 1 motif

25 g White 001

69 g Aqua 027

3,5 mm crochet hook

### MEASUREMENTS

#### BABY:

7 motifs (42 triangles) = 132 cm x 132 cm

You will therefore need:

2 balls White 001

5 balls Aqua 027

#### TODDLER:

10 motifs (60 triangles) = ±132 cm x 176 cm

You will therefore need:

3 balls White 001

7 balls Aqua 027

#### THROW:

17 motifs (102 triangles) = ±176 cm x 220 cm

You will therefore need:

5 balls White 001

12 balls Aqua 027

### TENSION

Is not essential. As long as all triangles are worked in an even tension, they should be approximately the same size.

### ABBREVIATIONS

This pattern uses UK crochet terminology

<b>beg</b> = begin(ning)	<b>rnd</b> = round
<b>ch</b> = chain	<b>slst</b> = slip stitch
<b>chsp</b> = chain space	<b>st(s)</b> = stitch(es)
<b>dc</b> = double crochet	<b>tog</b> = together
<b>fpdc</b> = front post double crochet	<b>tr</b> = treble
<b>fpdtr</b> = front post double treble	<b>ttr</b> = triple treble
<b>fptr</b> = front post treble	<b>yoh</b> = yarn over hook
<b>rep</b> = repeat	

### SPECIAL STITCHES

**fpdc** = insert hook behind stem of stitch and complete a double crochet as normal



**fp(d)tr** = work a (double)treble as normal inserting hook behind stem of stitch

### COLOUR CHANGE NOTE

Change colour neatly before completing last stitch by pulling new colour through stitch on hook.

### MAGIC RING

Wrap the yarn twice around your index and middle fingers, insert hook under the strands and pull through a loop. Slip the yarn from your fingers and work one chain stitch to secure the ring. Once you have worked the first round, pull on the shorter end to pull the ring closed.





### INSTRUCTIONS

(Make 6):

Using a 3,5 mm hook and Aqua beg with a magic ring.

**1<sup>st</sup> rnd:** 5ch (= 1tr and 2ch), (tr3tog, 5ch, tr3tog, 2ch) twice into ring, tr3tog in ring, 5ch, tr2tog leaving last 3 loops on hook, (pull ring closed), insert hook in 3<sup>rd</sup> of 5ch, yoh and pull through all loops on hook.

**2<sup>nd</sup> rnd:** \*(1dc, 2ch, 1dc) in 2chsp, (4dc, 2ch, 4dc) in 5chsp, rep from \* around, slst in first dc.

**3<sup>rd</sup> rnd:** 5ch (= 1tr and 2ch), \*miss 2ch, 2tr, fpdtr around 2<sup>nd</sup> dc in 2chsp, 2tr, 2tr in next dc, 3ch, 2tr in next dc, 2tr, fpdtr around first dc in 2chsp\*\*, 1tr in each of 2 missed dc behind fpdtr, 2ch, rep from \* around ending at \*\*, 1tr in missed dc behind fpdtr, slst in 3<sup>rd</sup> of 5ch.

**4<sup>th</sup> rnd:** 5ch (= 1tr and 2ch), \*miss 2ch, 4tr, fpdtr around fpdtr of 3<sup>rd</sup> rnd, 2tr, 2tr in next tr, 5ch, 2tr in next tr, 2tr, fpdtr around fpdtr of 3<sup>rd</sup> rnd, 1tr in each of the 2 missed tr behind fpdtr\*\*, 2tr, 2ch, rep from \* around ending at \*\*, 1tr, slst in 3<sup>rd</sup> of 5ch.

**5<sup>th</sup> rnd:** 5ch (= 1tr and 2ch), \*miss 2ch, 6tr, fpdtr around fpdtr of 4<sup>th</sup> rnd, 2tr, 2tr in next tr, 5ch, 1ttr in 3<sup>rd</sup> of 5ch, 5ch, 2tr in next tr, 2tr, fpdtr around fpdtr of 4<sup>th</sup> rnd, 1tr in each of the 2 missed tr behind fpdtr\*\*, 4tr, 2ch, rep from \* around ending at \*\*, 3tr, slst in 3<sup>rd</sup> of 5ch.

**6<sup>th</sup> rnd:** 1dc in same place as slst, \*1dc in 2chsp, 7dc, fpdc around fpdtr, 3dc, 6dc in 5chsp, 1dc in ttr, fptr around ttr, 1dc in same ttr behind fptr, 6ds in 5chsp, 3dc, fpdc around fpdtr, 1dc in missed dc behind fpdc\*\*, 6dc, rep from \* around ending at \*\*, 5dc, slst in first dc.

Fasten off.


**7<sup>th</sup> rnd:** Using White, slst in 4<sup>th</sup> dc from fasten off point, 3ch, 1tr over 3ch into 3<sup>rd</sup> dc, \*3ch, miss 3dc, 1tr in next dc, fptr around fpdc, 3tr, 3ch, miss 2dc, 1tr in next dc, tr2tog over next 2dc, 3ch, miss 1dc, 1tr in next dc, (2tr, 5ch, 2tr) in fptr, 1tr in dc, 3ch, miss 1dc, tr2tog over next 2dc, 1tr in next dc, 3ch, miss 2dc, 3tr, fptr around fpdc, 1tr\*\*, 3ch, (1tr in 5<sup>th</sup> dc, 1tr over tr into 4<sup>th</sup> dc) twice, rep from \* around ending at \*\*, 3ch, 1tr in 5<sup>th</sup> dc, 1tr over tr into 4<sup>th</sup> dc, 3ch, slst in top of 3ch.

Fasten off.

Block all triangles to measurement, cover with a damp cloth and allow to dry.

### JOINING TRIANGLES

Using a 3,5 mm hook and White, beg in middle ch at point of triangle and slst in each st with corresponding st of next triangle all along edge including 3ch at top corner.
